Letter from our Pastor

# An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Father, I abandon myself into your hands. Do with me what you will. Whatever you may do, I thank you. I am ready for all, I accept all. Let only your will be done in me, and in all your creatures. I wish no more than this, O Lord. Into your hands, I commend my soul. I offer it to you with all the love of my heart, for I love you, my Lord, and so need to give myself, to surrender myself into your hands, without reserve, and with boundless confidence, for you are my Father.

I keep a copy of this prayer at my desk in the rectory. I don't pray it often, but whenever I am feeling stressed or perplexed, somehow my eyes catch this prayer, which is next to the image of Our Lady of Confidence, the patroness of the Roman Seminary, where I was formed for the priesthood. The prayer was composed by Charles de Foucauld, who was canonized by Pope Francis last month. This swashbuckling adventurer and military man as a young adult was one of France's bright young things. After a difficult experience in the sacrament of confession with a very wise priest in the fashionable Church of St Augustine in Paris, this new Augustine abandoned the life of the world to become a Trappist monk. But the Lord revealed to him a new vocation that would take him out to the middle of nowhere in the Sahara Desert as a hermit living a hidden life like Jesus in Nazareth. His murder in 1916 by bandits was discovered later to be a martyrdom for charity.



The man lived an eremitical life alone, and died alone. But his example has inspired a number of religious and lay communities who have modeled their charisms on his simple gift of living love in the midst of an inhospitable environment.

I leave for Turkey this Friday, after celebrating the Feast of Corpus Christi in the EF with Solemn High Mass and a Procession of the Most Blessed Sacrament on Thursday at 7p. I hope you will be there, as I want to pray with as many of you as I can before going away. I'm scheduled to come back I August! I'm grateful for the opportunity to follow the inspiration of what the life of St Charles of Jesus shows, when we abandon ourselves to the mysterious designs of Providence, we never know where that will lead us. May Our Lady of Confidence and St Charles of Jesus protect and guide us all this summer, no matter where Love may bid us go.
