# **Guest Writers: Our Latin Mass Community**

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

We are honored to have been invited to write an article on what we would like our parish family to know about our Latin Mass community. Community is exactly what comes to mind when we think of what we have experienced at the Prince of Peace Latin Mass. We first discovered the Extraordinary Form of the Mass at Prince of Peace on Easter Sunday 2015. Our family experienced a hectic morning with the usual Easter Sunday celebrations in addition to a leaking sink. We were delayed in attending the 10am Mass and decided to attend the noon Mass. We experienced such an unexpected treat! We left Mass discussing the stunningly beautiful and somewhat different, but somehow extremely similar, liturgy. We would begin attending both the 10am and 12pm Mass over the next year. Little by little our hearts were pulled to the Latin Mass, not only for our personal preferences in the liturgy, but also because the families that attended the Latin Mass were so welcoming to us. These families have become our extended family, the relationships are not superficial ones but feel biblical in how we support and comfort one another. It's as if my children have an abundance of aunts and uncles who will gift them with Catholic art and sacramentals, and even once gave our son shoe laces because we kept forgetting to replace his worn out ones, as well as offer beautiful advice, guidance and prayers. If you have been curious about the Latin Mass please come join us - any family would be eager to help you navigate the missal (it's easier than it seems) and share what attracted them to the Latin Mass! A wonderful way to get a sense of our community is to join us during our Sunday potlucks - there is no need to bring anything just come and enjoy the food and fun and get to know the Prince of Peace Latin Mass community! If you are hesitating because of a lack of understanding Latin, we found these two books, <u>Treasure and Tradition</u> and <u>Nothing Superfluous</u>, to be helpful in explaining the origins and purpose for each word and act. They were not only tremendously helpful but also renewed our enthusiasm for Catholicism and drastically increased our faith formation.

We are so grateful for such a special parish where each Mass, both Ordinary and Extraordinary Form, is especially beautiful and expertly executed and we hope you will cherish the Latin Mass where 20+ alter servers serve God and you can experience the incredible moments of silent reverence where the veil of heaven is pulled back as we enjoy the Mass of the ages in which our ancestors worshipped. We have never experienced such a loving and supportive community as we have found at the Latin Mass and we truly want to share it with you - it is a place where a community comes together to raise saints! We will leave you with our beautiful tradition as an example of this, each Sunday after Mass parishioners pray the prayer of the Mother's of Lu at the Marian alter where we seek our Lady's intercession in helping us raise the children of our parish to seek God in all things and be open to choosing the religious life if God has so called them to it. Our simple and sincere desire as a community is to help one another along the way to our heavenly home and to one day be together again in heaven doing what we love - worshipping God to the best of our abilities!






