Guest Writers: Religious Education

Dear Parishioners,

Parents are the primary educators and influencers of their children in their Catholic Faith however, your parish is here to assist in that education. It's that time of year to register your children for Religious Education at our parish. Religious Education is available for registered parishioners' children K5-8th grade. If you chose to homeschool your child(ren) and are teaching religion at home, please fill out a homeschool RE registration form and turn it into me. This serves as a record for sacramental preparation.

In the Diocese of Charleston two years of preparation are required for First Holy Communion (FHC) and Confirmation. That traditionally means students should be registered for Ist, 2nd, 7th, and 8th grade Religious Education at a bare minimum. However, it is best to participate in classes every single year starting in K5. Let's pretend your child only participated up until 2nd grade and then disappeared from our program during 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grade. Your child then reappears in the 7th grade with only the knowledge of a second grader, missing out on in-depth study of the Ten Commandments, the Sacraments, general Bible knowledge, the Mass, and so much more. It would be like dropping out of math in the 2nd grade and expecting your child to have the building blocks of knowledge to succeed in algebra. Please, do not be a disappearing family after First Holy Communion. 2022-2023 Religious Education sessions begin on 21 August at 8:50a. Additional instructions will be sent in August, once your child is registered for Religious Education.

Registration forms for First Holy Communion and Confirmation will be available in mid-August. Please reach out to me, via e-mail if your child is homeschooled or at another local Catholic school besides POPCS. All RE and POPCS students will receive their forms in early September. We will have a MANDATORY parent meeting on Thursday 8 September in the Parish House. First Holy Communion parents will meet at 6p, and Confirmation parents will meet at 7:30p. One parent per child is required to be in attendance unless arrangements for an individual meeting are made with me. Please bring a copy of your child's baptismal certificate, the completed registration form, and fee to the meeting. All fees for sacraments go towards the purchase of curriculum, retreat costs, and reception costs. The amount collected each year rarely covers the cost associated with either sacrament and the parish makes up the difference. If ANY family is unable to pay a fee, please reach out to me and I will work something out with each individual family. First Holy Communion 2023 is scheduled for 6 May at 10a. Confirmation is scheduled by the Bishop's office and we do not have our date for Confirmation 2023.

We are still in need of catechists for our program. We are currently in need of a second 4th grade lead teacher, a 6th grade co-catechist, and substitutes. Please reach out to me for additional information or to volunteer for one of these roles. We will have our annual catechist training on Saturday 30 July from 9a-noon.


