An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

What a great honor it is for me as your school principal, and as a fellow parishioner, to share with you some updates regarding our school, now approaching its 20th year of operation. The school began as the POP Child Development Center in 2003 and evolved into a fully functioning Catholic school by 2009. Since then, the school has experienced the inevitable growing pains that come with being a young institution of faith and learning. Over the years, we weathered ups and down, trials and triumphs, and ebbs and flows in enrollment in personnel. It has been a great pleasure over the last three years to help calm the waters and set sail for the future.

Today we stand on solid financial, academic and spiritual footing. In many ways, the school has "grown up" and, in its maturity, is poised to look to the future to further carry out its mission to serve students and families in the Catholic faith. And with that solid ground beneath our feet, we intend to strengthen the foundations and build. This has come from a community of prayer, support and commitment to the very best in education. To that end, I would like to extend tremendous gratitude on behalf of the school for the prayers and support that has come from the parish since its inception in 2003. Father Smith has often touted our school as the primary apostolate of the parish for the handing down of the faith. With this wonderful accolade comes a tremendous responsibility to bring each and every student and family closer to God.

This last spring I worked with our faculty on a strategic exercise in getting to the heart of why we exist as a school. With great reflection and consensus, we landed on the following:

"Prince of Peace Catholic School exists to prepare each student to answer the call of God through faith, intellect and virtues, making them apostles of faith, so they can achieve sainthood. We graduate students that go out into the world prepared academically and spiritually to defend truth and promote justice."

This work with the faculty served as the start of establishing our next strategic plan for the school. On the heels of the work with the faculty, I began working with our School Advisory Council, who serve as the principle advisors to the pastor and principal on policy formation. Standing committees in finance, Catholic identity, finance, facilities and security, and marketing and enrollment worked during the Spring to set strategic goals for the future that would be folded into our strategic plan.

During the early part of the summer, I worked to develop a working draft of our strategic plan for 2022 through 2025. It serves as a roadmap ahead with clear direction and insight regarding the needs of the school to fully live out its mission.
