Letter from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

From time to time, we have opened our doors as a parish to others for things that don't benefit us directly at all. We've had people come from the Holy Land, college and university apostolate, the Catholic Near East Welfare Association. And if you have ever gotten on a Catholic mailing list, you get bombarded with trinkets and Mass cards begging for donations for any number of good causes. And that's all wonderful. But I had to ask myself as a pastor: how can we be involved as a parish family in something more concrete, some kind of need for foreign mission which isn't being met by anyone?

There is now a tangible link, through me, from this part of the vineyard, and another part of the vineyard. The Vicar Apostolic of Istanbul has asked our parish to adopt a parish in Turkey. Exactly what that relationship is going to look like, only God knows. It will develop. I ask that you consider supporting me in this endeavor. This Saturday, 10 September, from 6.30-9p, I am going to give a presentation called A *Fire Waiting to Be Lit: The History and Future of Catholicism in Turkey.* In this presentation, I am going to talk about what the present situation of the Church in Turkey is, and how we got here, as well as all of the amazing possibilities that make it an exciting local church to collaborate with. I ask that you come to the presentation and invite others who might be interested. That weekend, there will be an informative insert in the bulletin with a brief overview of what this is, and there will be of course, an opportunity to give a sacrificial gift. Sometimes we lose sight of the fact that something that can seem really small and inconsequential to us can actually be a massive factor for positive change for many other people. Now, of course, this is all voluntary. But I am praying that your minds and hearts may be open to this conversion to a way of being the Church that embraces a passion for foreign mission, not just in any way, but in a very specific way.

The First Ecumenical Council took place in the year 325 at Nicea. Every Sunday we pray the words of the Creed which was the fruit of a council which defined the Christian dogma that Jesus Christ is true God and true man. The closest Christian presence today is an hour away at Bursa, where Catholics, Protestants and Orthodox share one church that is not much larger than our Adoration Chapel. The lack of priestly vocations for the missions means they have Mass once a month, and the Catholics go to the Protestant service the other Sundays because there's no alternative. The Bishop wants to send a priest to reopen the church of the first ecumenical council in time for its 1700th anniversary, to bring back to life the local church in the place where the Church proclaimed the divinity of Christ. And to do that, they need to have a place for a priest to stay, and for the Church to gather and do the kinds of things that we do at Prince of Peace day in and day out, that the Catholic community of Bursa wants to do too, but there's no way to do it. Until now. If we have the heart to help.

Next week there will be an envelope in your bulletin to record your spiritual and/or financial contribution to the Anatolian Fund. That Fund will be forwarded to the Vicariate Apostolic of Istanbul with the view to help refound a more permanent presence of the life of the Church at the site of the first ecumenical council, whose 1700th anniversary is in 2025. Now of course, this being the Middle East, for reasons entirely outside of the control of the Vicariate, that might be impossible, in which the monies will be used by the Vicariate for some other worthy cause of church building and planting in the Istanbul area.
