Letter from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

In your bulletin today you will find an insert with more information about my mission experience in Turkey, and an invitation to help Bring Bursa Back. Last night I gave a presentation on the history and future of Catholicism in Turkey, as a means of getting people excited about pitching in together as a parish to do something beautiful for God. In the insert is an envelope where you may record your spiritual or financial contribution to this effort. This is all up to your generosity, of course, and whether the Spirit inspires you to choose this among so many worthy causes out there.

Please drop your envelope in the basket at Mass today, mail it in or bring it with you to church next Sunday. The Anatolian Fund here at Prince of Peace will be forwarded to the Vicariate Apostolic of Istanbul with the view to help refound a more permanent presence of the life of the Church at the



site of the first ecumenical council, whose I700th anniversary is in 2025. Now of course, this being the Middle East, for reasons entirely outside of the control of the Vicariate, that might be impossible, in which the monies will be used by the Vicariate for some other worthy cause of church building and planting in the Istanbul area.

If you would like more information on all of this, please contact Maria Rauch in the office for an appointment and we can sit down and parse through your questions and concerns about this daring new initiative of partnership between Prince of Peace and the Bursa Catholic Community in Turkey. I am deeply grateful for all of you who have already responded so generously, and for those who will be motivated this weekend to go. We have already gotten an offer from a parish family to fly the Bishop over from Turkey to talk about the project, which would be an amazing way to continue to forge links of goodwill between us and them!


