# Letter from our Pastor

# An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

The Church is a wise mother. She recognizes that grief is a process. Her liturgy accompanies her children in their grief and prays for the dead for a reason. There's the blessing and reception of a body, a vigil in the presence of the body, a Funeral Mass, the Final Commendation, the burial service, Masses traditionally offered on important days after death, and the Commemoration of All Souls. The Church wants us to deal with the reality of death so we can understand the hope that belongs to the Christian.

But more and more our increasingly secularized culture is becoming detached from the reality of death, and paradoxically, more hopeless. A culture of death which turns a blind eye to abortion, euthanasia, and genocide wants to ignore death and pretend it doesn't exist. And, so more and more families refuse to go through the Church's way of death that leads to life. They will wait until the last minute to call the priest for last rites, if they call him at all. Then, they say totally bizarre things like, "We don't want a full Mass." What does that even mean? They don't want to come to church. They want what little of a funeral there is to be

celebrated only at their convenience, with as little expense and bother as possible. And then they wonder why they have mental health issues related to it all.

Don't wait to get your affairs in order and start planning your full funeral rites, and finance their reality now. You may only see the worth of all of this for your loved ones left behind from your throne with Jesus in heaven, but you will. Don't leave it to anyone else. It saddens me to see a devout Catholic laid to rest without the full complement of Catholic ritual, because that worship has an incredible ability to heal and to inspire when done right.

And remember: all the sappy sentimental stuff: Leave it for the reception. That's not what Mass is about. Don't try to force onto the worship of God anything that isn't already a part of it. All of that stuff has a place, but it's outside of Mass.

In 1990, he professed his first vows as a Capuchin Franciscan friar. Making his Perpetual vows in 1993, he went on to earn his Master's degree in theology in 1995 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1997. Fr. Joseph's first assignment after ordination was in Papua New Guinea in the South Pacific where he served for four years. Returning to the US in 2001, he has served in various capacities as parochial vicar, pastor, military and hospital chaplain and has also served in Puerto Rico.

Fr. Joseph currently serves as the national director of the Archconfraternity of Christian Mothers and in fulltime preaching ministry for the Capuchin Province of St. Augustine, offering retreats and reflection days for parishes, Religious and Priests.




