### Letter from our Pastor

### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Your favourite Advent Grinch miraculously morphs into the Grinch Who Gripes if You Stop Christmassing Too Early. Maybe there's a shorter term for that, but if there is, I am sure one of you will let me know. The Solemnity of the Epiphany is actually older than Christmas in the history of the liturgy. The Twelfth Night of Christmas was for centuries a rich celebration of the Divinity and the Royalty of Christ, with its own eight day octave of celebration. There were a number of fascinating customs that grew up in Catholic cultures around this feast, but of course, our secularized world has seen them all but disappear in most places. More's the pity.

But you won't be surprised that at Prince of Peace, we're not going to let that happen. This year we are going to do all the Epiphany things you can possibly imagine, as we have a three day Epiphany Festival. So mark your calendars, because you're invited every night of the Festival.

On Thursday, 5 January we are going to do something we have never done before. Many of you may be aware of the 19<sup>th</sup> century Anglican paraliturgical service called Lessons and Carols that started at Kings' College Cambridge. This service has become a staple of English-speaking Christmas celebrations far beyond the Church of England. At 7p, we will celebrate Epiphany Lessons and Carols, with readings from Scripture as well as a chance to sing together oldies but goodies of the Christmas season. After that, we will bless gold, frankincense and myrrh for the children as well as chalk for everyone to go home after and bless their doors with. The traditional Blessing of Epiphany Water with the singing of the Te Deum will be done after that. So bring all the things to be blessed, and put them on the tables provided in the church. What a way to bring out of the treasure house things old and new from our Roman Catholic and Anglophone Christian traditions.

On Friday, 6 January at 7p we will celebrate the Solemn High Mass of the Epiphany on the traditional date in the classical Latin form of the liturgy. We will follow it with another restored and recovered custom, the Benediction at the Crib, where the image of the Baby Jesus will be replaced by the monstrance with the Most Blessed Sacrament for Benediction.

And finally, on Saturday 7 January we will have our Three Kings Party in the PAC, where kids can dress up like figures in the Nativity and enjoy a family friendly festival to mark the transition from Epiphanytide to Carnevale, that season of merriment before we have to get serious again before Lent. A time to share each other's company and be a little wild and crazy in a good wholesome way. You won't want to miss the party of the year, so bring your friends and enjoy the fun.

The Ordinary Form transfers the liturgical celebration of the Epiphany to the nearest Sunday, so that weekend will be Epiphany in the New Rite. So more time to celebrate!
