Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Last week in my bulletin column I excerpted an article about a community of priests in the Church called the Oratory. The first Oratory in the United States was actually founded in our own diocese, in Rock Hill, in 1934. The Oratorians are known for their particularly Roman spirit, and the English Oratories have brought that spirit to the Anglophone world. When I was on sabbatical at Oxford, I had the great grace to glimpse the life of the Oratory in Oxford at close range. The superior of the Oratory, the Provost, is Father Nicholas Edmonds-Smith, a South African cradle Catholic who entered the community after being a student there. Ordained a priest in 2011, Father Nicholas has presided over a flowering of Catholic life in a place known for the most prestigious university in the world. Vocations to the community and to the priesthood and religious life for other communities, as well as conversions to the Catholic faith have seen an incredible rate of growth there.



I asked Fr Nicholas if we would come and preach our Lenten Mission, which he will do during the weekend of St Joseph/Laetare, 19-21 March. This year we will do that Mission in the context of forty hours of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, a devotion known as the *Quarant'Ore*, popularized by the founder of the Oratory, St Philip Neri. That weekend, there will be an envelope in your bulletin to give a sacrificial love offering for the important work that they do among the university community. College apostolates are difficult anywhere, but Oxford presents a unique place for people from all over the world to seek truth where there is a particularly vibrant Catholic presence. We ask that you plan to give generously to this mission. Having a parish with college kids with no disposable income and men knocking on the doors to become priests is a unique situation. Once you hear Father Nicholas preach, I know you will support that mission as much I do.

south carolina abortion facts

In South Carolina, abortion is presently legal up to 24 weeks post-conception. With the recent ruling by the state Supreme Court striking down a Fetal Heartbeat Law, South Carolina serves as a safe haven for abortionists. There are two avenues to solve this crisis:

- Gov. Henry McMaster has pledged his commitment to fighting this injustice in court. He has petitioned to re-appeal at the S.C. Supreme Court.
- The state General Assembly has re-filed its Human Life Protection Act, which significantly limits abortion post-conception and protects the lives of mothers.

The South Carolina Catholic Conference, a public policy voice for Catholics, supports these causes and is actively working this legislative session to pass the Human Life Protection Act. 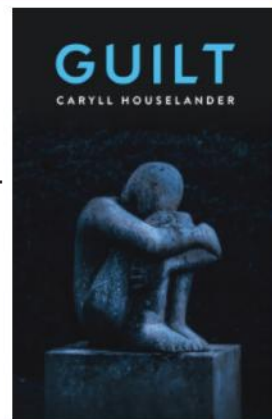
