Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

The Bishops of the United States have called for a Eucharistic Revival in our country. God knows we need it. The percentage of Catholics who attend Mass every Sunday has seen a precipitous decline over the past few decades, and it is no secret that after COVID, it has gotten worse. Even those who have stayed, in many places have been formed (or malformed) by irreverent and even sacrilegious celebrations of the Mass. There is a fundamental confusion about the teaching of the Church on the Eucharist, and what the discipline of the Church is on the reception of Holy Communion, and why it is there.

We may not see this as much in a parish like Prince of Peace. Our Mass attendance is growing. Many of our people are well catechized and come here because they want a place where Eucharistic renewal is not just a program for a

time, but a way of life. But in absolute terms, the number of people checking out of the Catholic faith is outpacing those that are engaging it. That is why it is important for Prince of Peace to be a center of excellence, not just any parish church. But that is the challenge, not just for clergy and staff, but for all of us.

Next week we start our Quarant'Ore, the Forty Hours of Eucharistic Devotion. I am asking every person who calls Prince of Peace their spiritual home to participate in some way, by taking one hour of adoration during this time period. We also urge you not to wait to the last minute, but come to confession during this time period and attend the lectures. They will be important to rev up everything we need to do as part of this revival in our parish!

south carolina abortion facts

In South Carolina, abortion is presently legal up to 24 weeks post-conception. With the recent ruling by the state Supreme Court striking down a Fetal Heartbeat Law, South Carolina serves as a safe haven for abortionists. There are two avenues to solve this crisis:

- Gov. Henry McMaster has pledged his commitment to fighting this injustice in court. He has petitioned to re-appeal at the S.C. Supreme Court.
- The state General Assembly has re-filed its Human Life Protection Act, which significantly limits abortion post-conception and protects the lives of mothers.

The South Carolina Catholic Conference, a public policy voice for Catholics, supports these causes and is actively working this legislative session to pass the Human Life Protection Act. ABOUT

Ordained on the Feast of St Thérèse of Lisieux in 2011, Fr Nicholas is a priest in the Archdiocese of Birmingham serving as Provost of The Oratory of Oxford (England). The Oratory does not have a detailed rule to follow, other than the life of St Philip Neri himself. The Oratory's primary mission is to sanctify the people of Oxford through prayer, preaching and the daily administration of the sacraments. His talks will build upon: "I put before you the one great thing to love on earth: the Blessed Sacrament."

HISTORY OF DEVOTION

The Forty Hours' Devotion (Quarant'Ore) originated in Milan in 1534. The Blessed Sacrament was displayed on the altar continually for 40 hours during a time of calamity and danger. The faithful were encouraged to come and take turns praying. This devotion soon spread to other parts of Italy and in 1548, St. Philip Neri introduced it to Rome. The collective adoration of the exposed Eucharist for a period of 40 hours is in honor of the time Our Lord spent in the tomb (no single person is expected to spend 40 hours in adoration).

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

The Guild of St Thomas Aquinas will transition from the Chapel to the Church, maintaining their regular hour(s) of adoration beginning after 12n Mass on Sunday, 19 March. The Chapel will re-open after the 7p Mass on Tuesday, 21 March.

All parishioners are invited to adopt at least 30 minutes of prayer time before the Blessed Sacrament during Quarant'Ore. Adoration is paused during Mass.

When visiting the Blessed Sacrament as the 40 Hours Devotion goes on, we are to recite a sequence of prayers, such as the rosary, or an Our Father, a Hail Mary, and a Glory be 5 times — the last cycle being for the intentions of the Holy Father. If one does this after having gone to Confession and received Communion, one receives a plenary indulgence (under the usual conditions).


