Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

There's a great scene in Margaret Mitchell's *Gone with the Wind* of the O'Hara family in the living room praying the *Confiteor* and praying the Rosary together as a family. It used to be very common for Catholic families to pray the Rosary every night together. Catholic housewives would time their pasta literally by the decade, and Catholic men wouldn't be caught dead without a pair of beads in their pocket. Grandma's rosary beads always became a family heirloom, and treasured as an almost totemic object by descendants who lost the faith she taught to them with love and tenacity.

Of course, the use of beads to count prayers exists in all kinds of different religions. In Muslim countries, it is normal for men to carry a 99 bead rosary called the *tesbih* as they perform a devotion called *dhikr* of aspirations to God in honor of the 99 names of Allah revealed in the Qu'ran. Those beads actually come from the *chotki* of Eastern Catholics and Orthodox who pray the Jesus Prayer on them. The Western rosary as we know it today was popularized by St Dominic in the 13th century.

But do you know how to pray the Rosary? Do you actually pray it? Do you pray it alone or with your family every day? Do you carry a blessed pair of beads with you?
