Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As a general rule I don't like fake things in church: flowers, candles, vestments, organs and bells. But sometimes you have to make do with what you have, which is why we have had an electronic organ since the new church was built. Very often parishioners come up to me with questions like, "Why don't we have..." fill in the blank, and I look at them and say, "Well, write me a check and I will be glad to provide it for you!" The weekly offertory goes to the normal operating budget and day to day maintenance of the parish. Funds like our part of the Bicentennial Campaign go to capital projects and improvements. The decision of what gets priority is very rarely mine alone to make, especially when it comes to big ticket items. The staff, the finance council and the finance subcommittee of the School Advisory Council all are all involved in the process of determining how we spend your investment in the parish. And then an air conditioner breaks, and we have to shuffle the deck again!

When we do not make our target for the weekly offertory or the Bicentennial Campaign, it means that things keep getting put down the list. Now, don't get me wrong, your generosity has made possible a number of amazing projects, but there's still so much to do, because we are a growing parish with lots of needs. Those of you who are giving can hardly be expected to give more. But we do have people who come to Mass who I am inviting to prayerfully consider how they think about giving to the parish.

For example, at the end of April of this year, we were 76K over budget in offertory, but for the month we were down \$8669. In the grand scheme of things, that is not an amount to break the bank. But, that 76K over ended up covering higher expenses because of inflation, adding to savings and catching up on projects already identified and put on back burners we hadn't gotten to without that money. But, the lack of that \$8669 meant that we could not pull the trigger on a project I would like to see funded: an electronic bell system that cost almost exactly that much for purchase and installation. It's not ideal, but building a bell tower with real bells in it cast in a foundry and shipped and installed here is a massive project that would be awesome to have but is really low on the priorities list right now, and won't be on the list probably for decades. In the meantime, we could have something not ideal but nice but that little blip in the budget meant that wasn't going to happen. I think of that every time I have a wedding and think how nice it would be for new Mr and Mrs to exit to church bells...

The Bicentennial Campaign's parish proceeds have allowed us to totally redo the lighting in the church and all over campus, replace several HVACs, replace decks, provide for live streaming, improve technology, replace and redo flooring in the church and Guadelupe Hall, replace roofs, install cameras and secure access systems, and more. But we still have so many projects on that list: a massive replacement of HVACs in the church, remodeling bathrooms, completing the maintenance building, replacing the sound system in church and Croghan Hall, replacing playground equipment, and recovering the pews in the church. Right now, we are well over half way through the campaign. Throughout the diocese, 69% of the pledges have been collected. But at Prince of Peace, only 64% of our pledges have been fulfilled. That means that those items that were identified at the beginning of the campaign that have not been done yet may take years more to see happen at our parish, and they were all identified as urgent high price needs. We will survive, of course, but when it gets toasty in church because we can't replace the HVAC, and I have to keep dry cleaning vestments from sweating through them during the summer, please remember why this is the case.


