Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In sixteenth century Spain, there was a votive mass and local feast of the Precious Blood. Saint Gaspar del Bufalo introduced these texts into Italy. In the United States, the Friday after the Laetare Sunday in Lent was observed with a local commemoration of the Precious Blood. In 1849, Pope Pius IX was forced into exile on the island of Gaeta as Italian nationalists sought to unify their country at the expense of the papal states. The superior of the Precious Blood Fathers, Giovanni Merlini, was his companion in exile, and suggested that if the Pope extended the Feast of the Precious Blood to the universal Church, he would gain the papal states back. The pope decided that it was a good idea even if he didn't get the papal states back, and the feast was assigned to the first Sunday of July. Pope St Pius X moved it to the first day of July and declared July the Month of the Precious Blood. In 1969, the feast was abolished and the Mass formulary reduced to a votive mass that could be celebrated when there wasn't a saint's memorial on the calendar.

While the development of the feast was decidedly modern, its abolition was rather rationalist (Corpus Christi became the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ). There is value in considering the Precious Blood as the emblem of the Atonement on the Cross. Blood is an important element in the Levitical sacrifices of the Old Law, and it's hard to understand the Eucharist and the Redemption apart from that.

Plus, the nineteenth century saw a boom in new hymns composed that fleshed out the spirituality of the Precious Blood, both in Catholic and Protestant circles. In 1899, Lewis Jones, who worked at a YMCA wrote a hymn based on his preacher's sermons, a hymn that I loved to sing in the Baptist church growing up, and haven't ever sung since. But it is a lovely text, and we share it today for your edification!

I Would you be free from the burden of sin?
There's power in the blood, power in the blood;
Would you o'er evil a victory win?
There's wonderful power in the blood.

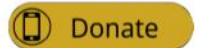

a note from fr smith

The church is not the dumping ground for all of the unblessed sacramentals you get in the mail, nor is it the place for you to put your own devotional literature for things you may like. Every week we have to go through the adoration chapel and church and throw away things no one has authorized to be there. Often people get very enthusiastic about some particular devotion, and want to share it by putting thousands of copies of a book or booklet or pamphlet in their church. Now, I encourage you to share your own spiritual life and items which have helped your journey. But I must discourage you from using the parish church as a platform for it. When people pick up things in church, they assume that the parish has authorized it. And so when people pick up pamphlets about unapproved Marian apparitions or polemical literature, they assume the pastor has approved it. And then we get clutter all over the place, and I go on the occasional purge of "Throw all this out" to keep the narthex and chapel tidy.

The Bible. The Catechism. The Missal. Classics of spiritual literature. Lives of the saints. Nothing else.

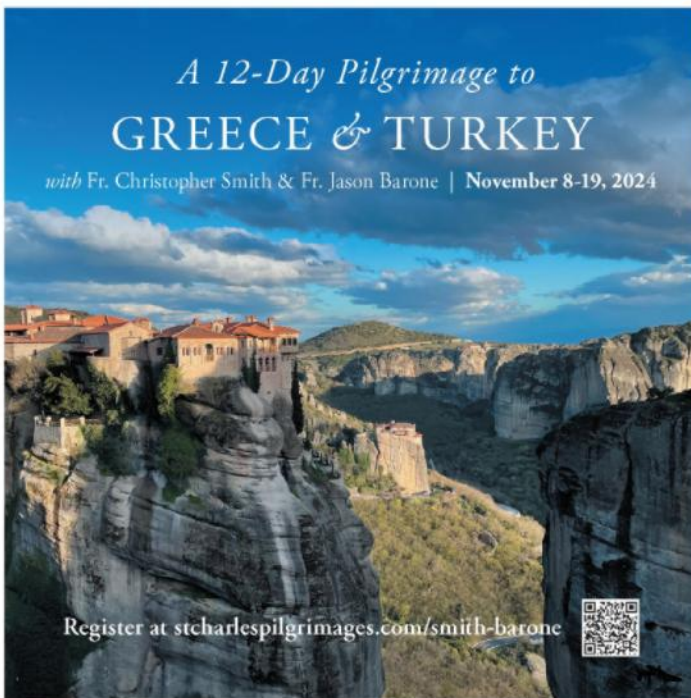

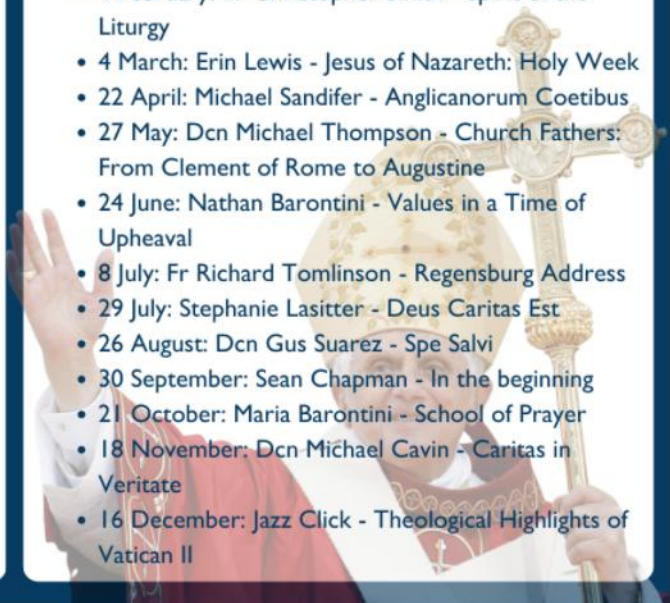
