Letter from Dcn Bob Smith

## An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the third reflection on the Eucharist, I will discuss the necessity of attending Mass even if we cannot receive the Eucharist.

Mass for me is the pinnacle of my worship and I strive to attend Mass every day I can, whether at home or while travelling. I believe the purpose of Mass is to worship God, to participate in the re-presentation of Christ's own sacrifice of Himself on the Cross and in His Resurrection, and to try to elevate my life to be closer to God. We will only get out of our relationship with God what we put into it. In Mass, we gather as a member of the Body of Christ and place ourselves in the hand of God.

Mass is the perfect sacrifice, created by Christ at the Last Supper. Catechism #1325 states that the Mass is the culmination of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship we offer to Christ and through Him to the Father in the Holy Spirit. Mass is the gateway to the Eucharist and without Mass there is no Eucharist. Mass is inseparable from the Eucharist.

If we really think about who we are, who God is, and how much we owe God, we should want to go to Mass. Mass should be the source and center of our own spiritual life. Bishop Fulton Sheen said that if you do not get anything out of Mass, it is because you have the wrong expectations for the Mass. He goes on to say Mass is not for our entertainment, but is the worship of the God who made us and saved us and gave us the gift of the Mass. How can we refuse this gift?

I have come up with 10 reasons to attend Mass on Sunday for which you may add or altar as you see fit.

- 1. God commanded it in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Commandment, to keep holy the Sabbath. During Jesus's time on earth, He would not have considered missing worship on the Sabbath or Jewish high feasts.
- 2. Jesus commanded it at the Last Supper when He established the Eucharist and the priesthood. This was the first Mass. He instructed us to do this in memory of Himself.
- 3. The Church commands it as stated in the Catechism that we must attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Other commands include not receiving when in state of mortal sin and following the Church laws of fast and abstinence.
- 4. Church authority on faith and morals is absolute because Christ's authority is absolute. He handed this authority to the Church when He stated to Peter and the apostles that whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven.
- 5. Mass is the perfect sacrifice created by Jesus. Through the priest, we offer, in an unbloody way. Jesus' Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity to the Father as Jesus did on the Cross, along with His Resurrection, which fulfilled the will of His Father.
- 6. God made us to be social beings and He wants us to come together and worship Him. Jesus promised us that if we gather in His Name, He is present.
- 7. We have a responsibility to raise our children in the faith and to set the example. Children must see in your actions the importance of the Mass.
- 8. Sunday is a day of thanksgiving (Eucharist means thanks). We should give thanks daily but must on Sunday in highest form of communal prayer, the Mass. Both private and communal prayer are necessary for a good spiritual life.
- 9. We receive the Liturgy of the Word, another way God is present to us in the Mass.
- 10. Going to Mass is our loving response to the God that loved us first. It is our active choice to share our time, talent and treasure with God both at home and away.


