Letter from Dcn Gus Suárez

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Tradition holds that St. Philip Neri, upon noticing that a man left Mass immediately upon receiving the Blessed Sacrament, sent altar servers with candles to follow him home, much to the man's embarrassment and chagrin. When the man demanded to know why Philip had done so, the Saint responded that he had sent the servers to honor to the Lord's Presence—something that the man had neglected to do. How often do we do the same? How often do we fall short of recognizing the fact that what we have received in the appearance of bread is the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ?

In his gem of a book, *The Blessed Eucharist: Our Greatest Treasure*, Fr. Michael Müeller notes that our Lord could have chosen to make His presence in the Holy Eucharist more overt, but He chose not to do so:

There is nothing in this Sacrament nothing that breathes of majesty. Our Lord is silent, whether we leave the church immediately or kneel and reverently converse with him. The stones do not cry out against our ingratitude if, after eating the bread of Angels, we did not give thanks to God. Jesus might send twelve legions of angels to stand around us after we have left his Table to remind us that He is present in our hearts, but He does not do this.



So why does Christ choose to make His Presence in the Eucharist silent and all but hidden? Perhaps it is because He does not want us to respond to His Presence in the Eucharist out of a sense of awe or fear, but rather out of love. As Fr. Müeller puts it: "This... is a Sacrament of Love. In it God is pleased to treat with His creatures in all familiarity. Jesus Christ... draws nigh to converse with us, as He did to the two disciples on their way to Emmaus... as one friend speaks to another."

We are given an incredible invitation when we receive the Eucharist. The God who made the world and all that is in it wants to spend time with **you**. He wants to dwell in your heart and hear about your problems and your concerns, as a friend listens to a friend. He knows you and loves you, and wants you to know Him and Love Him. Let us accept this great invitation and spend some time with the Lord as he dwells in our hearts, giving Him thanks for this greatest of gifts.

ALL First Holy Communion YEAR 2 and Confirmation YEAR 2 registration forms must be turned in prior to the yearly December deadline for a child to participate in a spring sacrament.
