Letter from Dcn Mark Thompson

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have reached our sixth and final week of our sermon series by your deacons on the Eucharistic Renewal. We have covered why we need a Eucharistic renewal, how to prepare for communion, the value of mass if you do not receive, why we make an Act of Thanksgivings after communion and why adoration is important. Today our sermon, I hope, will make you think of yourselves and eternity. Today's sermon is "How can the Eucharist make Saints?"

When I chose this topic, I did not look at the subject, I noticed the date – 13 August. This is my wife and my anniversary. I said to myself, what a great day to do the Lord's work. For 35 years I have loved my gift from God and she has returned that love to me. When I saw the topic and started researching how the Eucharist can make Saints, I saw love. Love of God for His Son, love of the Son for His Father, and the love of both of them for all of us. When I was in diaconate formation classes, on one particular Saturday, I overheard diaconate candidates talking about the shortest homily. As they laughed and joked, one said "I love Jesus." Another chirped "I Love." The shortest came next. He just said "Love."

We have heard love mentioned or implied in the other homilies during this sermon series. But, like I said earlier, my research found love everywhere. The list of people who became Saints are Saints because they loved the Eucharist and were willing to die for it. Some of these Saints are well known and some get very little recognition.

I read the Saints of the Day in the Laudate app everyday and this is where I learn about some of the lesser-known Saints who are Saints because they loved Jesus and the Eucharist. Saint Lola of Brazil lived 60 years eating nothing but the Eucharist alone. The 19 Martyrs of Gorkum were killed by a Calvinist because of their loyalty to the Pope and belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. There is Saint Tarcisius, a third century boy, who died protecting the Eucharist he was taking to Christians condemned to die in prison.

Of course, there were many popular and well- known saints who loved the Eucharist and this love helped them lead lives that led to their sainthood. Saints such as Thomas Aquinas, who said "the Eucharist is the bread of Angels." St. John Paul II, who said "the Eucharist is the secret of my day." Saint Joan of Arc, who after being captured wanted nothing more the to receive the Eucharist.

St. Josemaría Escrivá said we are all called to be saints. Love of the Eucharist is a good way to begin your pathway to sainthood. It can start by returning the love God and Jesus have for you and it can growth with the gift Jesus gave us in the Eucharist.
