Letter from Dcn Nestor Acosta

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In this present societal atmosphere of relativistic messages and directives, we attempt to navigate through a relentless barrage which at times can leave us and our families confused and outright distressed. What is one to do to maintain our sanity and garner a ray of hope, a sense of tranquility? At times it may seem like we are journeying through a desert of hopelessness or even anguish, yet up ahead we can perceive what for most others may present as a mere optical illusion, a mirage. There we stumble upon the reality of an oasis; an Oasis which is always within reach, waiting for all of us Catholics: The *Blessed Sacrament*!

"<u>Why is Eucharistic Adoration important</u>?" We are so privileged at Prince of Peace Church to have access at every hour of the day to our own Adoration Chapel, an oasis of respite and refreshment. And there we find our Lord enthroned up high in a beautiful and majestic manner, where we may always go to pay Him homage. It is a sacred space in which we might dare to *talk less and listen more*. A place where we kneel or sit in front of the same God that placed within our hearts the Natural Law. In this chapel, an inner sanctum of supernatural blessings, the Creator of the universe and our Creator speaks directly to us, leading and guiding us in how to fulfill His Will. The Lord lets us know in our heart, deep in our being, the mission that He has for each of us for this earthly existence. Thus, as Christ always made sure to do the Father's Will, we can also strive to be true to His Will. Anytime we make a concerted effort to truly listen to God, we may be more apt to fulfill His Will, which inevitably results in gaining true peace and consolation!

Scripture helps us understand how to go about listening for God, so as to potentially experience His Presence. In the *First Book of Kings*, Elijah fears that king Jezebel will find him and kill him. Thus, Elijah hides in a mountain cave where the Lord instructs him to go and wait outside the cave, because "*the Lord will be passing by*." Then came a heavy wind, crushing the rocks, "but the Lord was not in the wind." An earthquake followed the wind, "but the Lord was not in the earthquake." After this there was a fire, "but the Lord was not in the fire." Then, "after the fire there was a *tiny whispering* sound...Elijah hid his face in his cloak." A voice said "*Elijah, why are you here*?" (Ch 19:1-21).

As Elijah did, we too may perceive the Lord's voice in the depths of our heart while adoring Him, whether in an adoration chapel or as the Lord is exposed on top of the altar. In the one and only prayer that Christ taught his disciples, the Lord's Prayer, we say "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." As we seek to know God's Will in our lives, our will may become increasingly attuned to His. In this way, we can partake in God's Will so that it may be done here "on earth as it is in heaven." Consequently, we may then take a breather in times of confusion and find rest and clarity in the Presence of the Lord, leaving that sacred space endowed with a supernatural sense of tranquility, hope, and love!
