### Letter from our Pastor

### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I'm getting my suggested reading for the parish for the season of Advent to you now so you can order it in time for the sacred season. Like many of you, I have been watching the current tragic events in the Holy Land very closely. As we get closer to Christmas, we often think about those places associated with the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus. And the fact that the place where the Prince of Peace was born sees so little peace in our own time is a weight on the whole world. As we read the Bible, it is important for us to realize that, in order to understand more fully what we are reading, we have to know about the culture in which Jesus is operating. When we read everything merely through the lens of our own culture and experience, we can miss out on crucial aspects of the message, and then lose the vital connection between Jesus' time and place and ours.

Nadim Nassar is an Anglican priest from Syria. The Culture of God has to be one of the most interesting pieces of modern spiritual literature I have ever read, and I urge you to adopt it for Advent. Nassar weaves in his own experience of growing up in the Middle East with profound meditations on how parables and events in the life of Jesus come alive when we understand certain things about the culture of the Levant, and how God reveals a culture through, with and in that culture which challenge and transform those cultures as well as our own. He also offers a deep explanation of how the mission of Jesus can bring true peace and the transfiguration of religion. And that is a very contemporary and much needed message.

Two caveats, however: as an evangelical Anglican, Nassar has a different conception of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist than we do. But his reflections on the Eucharist still have much value. Also, the modern tic of "spiritual, not religious" also manifests itself in his work in a way that Catholics, who see religion as a virtue perfected by faith, not replaced by it, would find strange.

But there is a very important message here. The culture of God is not about replacing the pharisaism of the Mosaic Law and the totalitarianism of certain interpretations of Islamic Law with a Catholic version of the same thing. The freedom of the children of God in the Spirit risks being eclipsed by those who see faith as just being nice on the one hand and those who reduce Catholicism to the mere observance of external traditions on the other. Reconnecting the tradition of the Catholic faith with the spiritual weight of the freshness of the Gospel is necessary to bring true peace to our individual lives and our world. I am grateful for this book, and I hope you will be too.

#### year b begins soon

Did you know the Lectionary is arranged in two cycles, one for Sundays and one for weekdays? The Sunday cycle is divided into three years, labeled A, B and C. In Year A, we read mostly from the Gospel of Matthew. In Year B, we read the Gospel of Mark and chapter 6 of the Gospel of John. In Year C, we read the Gospel of Luke. The Gospel of John is read during the Easter season in all three years. The year of the cycle does not change on January I, but on the First Sunday of Advent which is the beginning of the liturgical year.

The first reading, usually from the Old Testament, reflects important themes from the Gospel reading. The second reading is usually from one of the epistles, a letter written to an early church community. These letters are read semi-continuously. Each Sunday, we pick up close to where we left off the Sunday before, though some passages are never read.

We begin year B readings in the St Isaac Jogues Missals on 3 December.

#### OF christ the king

Christ the King Mass in Ordinary Form is 26 November. The St. Cecilia Choir will sing Claudio Monteverdi's Messa da Cappella a quattro voci from the composer's monumental sacred collection of 1641, Selva morale e spirituale, or "Moral and Spiritual Forest."

There will be one Mass on Thanksgiving at 9a in English.

#### rorate mass

Join us for Rorate Mass on Saturdays in Advent, 9,16, and 23 December, at 6.30a in Latin. The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet.

A Solemn High Rorate Mass will be 9 December.


