## Letter from our Pastor

#### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is the last Sunday of the liturgical year and that means we start a new year of grace with the First Sunday of Advent next week. That means it is a good time to remind everyone of proper etiquette in church, so we can resolve to break bad habits and begin the new year with good ones.

When attending Mass it is proper to do the following:

- Dress modestly and appropriately before the Lord.
- Arrive to Mass on time.
- Make the sign of the cross with holy water upon entering the Church.
- Men and boys, kindly remove hats or caps before the Lord.
- Genuflect facing the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle before entering your pew or altar. If unable to genuflect, a heartfelt bow is acceptable.
- Please turn off (or to vibrate) all cell phones prior to entering the Church.
- Please be "prayerfully silent". Refrain from unnecessary talking as it distracts others who are intently
  praying and reflecting.
- Join in the singing, and sing your praises to the Lord. Give Him thanks.
- Listen to the readings as God speaks to you directly through His words.
- There should be nothing in your mouth prior to receiving Holy Communion.
- Catholics, receive Holy Communion with reverence.
- Please exit the church only after the final song and after the celebrant has completed the recessional procession.
- Please be sure to take all your belongings and leave the pew and missal ready for the next Mass participant.

#### year b begins soon

Did you know the Lectionary is arranged in two cycles, one for Sundays and one for weekdays? The Sunday cycle is divided into three years, labeled A, B and C. In Year A, we read mostly from the Gospel of Matthew. In Year B, we read the Gospel of Mark and chapter 6 of the Gospel of John. In Year C, we read the Gospel of Luke. The Gospel of John is read during the Easter season in all three years. The year of the cycle does not change on January I, but on the First Sunday of Advent which is the beginning of the liturgical year.

The first reading, usually from the Old Testament, reflects important themes from the Gospel reading. The second reading is usually from one of the epistles, a letter written to an early church community. These letters are read semi-continuously. Each Sunday, we pick up close to where we left off the Sunday before, though some passages are never read.

We begin year B readings in the St Isaac Jogues Missals on 3 December.

#### OF christ the king

Christ the King Mass in Ordinary Form is 26 November. The St. Cecilia Choir will sing Claudio Monteverdi's Messa da Cappella a quattro voci from the composer's monumental sacred collection of 1641, Selva morale e spirituale, or "Moral and Spiritual Forest."

On Gaudete Sunday (17 December), all expectant mothers are invited to receive a special blessing at the 10a & 12p Masses.

#### rorate mass

Join us for Rorate Mass on Saturdays in Advent, 9,16, and 23 December, at 6.30a in Latin. The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet.

• A Solemn High Rorate Mass will be 9 December.


