Letter from our Pastor, Fr Christopher Smith

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Paschal Mystery: the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ is one single event that brought about our salvation. We tend to think of them as separate events that historically unfolded one after another, but they are all one Event which becomes the centerpiece of all time. The liturgical commemoration of the Paschal Mystery focuses on certain elements in each particular celebration, but it is one Event, namely, the consummation of God's plan to reveal His love in its fullness.

That requires a response, one of faith and generosity. Easter isn't just a nice spring celebration. It is the central axis around which all history, and our history, revolves. Today we begin the fifty day season of Paschaltide. A time in which we no longer fast because we rejoice that the LORD has rescued us all from the jaws of death. A time in which we give thanks for the newly baptized and those who have come into full communion with the Catholic Church this Easter, and resolve to accompany these neophytes as they take their first steps of faith. A time in which we take the lessons learned from Lent and apply them to the discipline of joy.

Easter isn't a time when Lenten penance is over. It is a time in which the fruits of our penance and mortification can be seen, and put to the test. Did you fail at some point during your Lenten journey? Don't despair, but give thanks to God that He revealed to you where the idols are in your heart that must be smashed as we come to the table of plenty. Did you do really well? Don't stop now! Even if we don't fast as such, let's not give ourselves over to gluttony and indulgence. Was your Lent kinda meh, half good and half not as good as it could have been? Well, this is the day the LORD has made so rejoice and be glad in it and get on with the merriment of Resurrection glory!

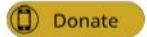

Did you know fifty years ago, in March 1974, the Parish and Goals Development Committee of St Mary’s in downtown Greenville met and decided there needed to be a new parish on the Eastside. That same month the new community was entitled the Greer-Taylor’s Endeavor. Mass was held in various Protestant churches, such as Grace Methodist Church in Greer, until September 1974 when we the new mission was hosted more stably at Lee Road United Methodist Church. In October 1974 14.5 acres of land was purchased with the generous help of St Mary’s parishioners for a new parish. In June 1975 the Greer-Taylor’s Endeavor came to an end and was split into two new communities. On 12 December 1975 Bishop Unterkoefler erected the Taylor’s community as Prince of Peace with Christmas as the Patronal Feast.

This means that we have embarked on the fiftieth anniversary of the place we call a spiritual home. We have a number of exciting events planned all the way until the official Closing of the Golden Jubilee of Prince of Peace on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Friday, 12 December 2025.

We ask that, if you have unwanted items that have to do with the history of the parish, you consider donating them to the Archives. After Easter, we will have a survey to ask parishioners about their commitment to a capital campaign for the future of Prince of Peace, with special emphasis on music and our award-winning school, that will begin during the Jubilee Year. It’s a big year for us, and I invite every single family who calls Prince of Peace their spiritual home to consider recruiting one other family to join us! Happy Anniversary and on with the Party!

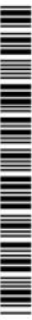
