## Letter from the Principal

#### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Last week, we introduced a proposal for the construction of a new pipe organ—a testament to our commitment to enriching our worship experience. As we continue to plan for the future of our community, I am excited to share with you another pivotal initiative: the expansion and enhancement of our school and parish facilities. This ambitious endeavor, estimated at \$1.3 - \$1.5 million, stands as a testament to our dedication to providing an environment that fosters the spiritual, intellectual, and social development of all members of our community.

The proposed enhancements to our school facilities will yield numerous benefits, not only for our students but for the entire parish community:

#### Some Key Benefits to the School:

- **I. Creating a Modern, Secure School Entrance and Lobby.** The construction of a new secure entry and administrative space will not only enhance safety protocols but will also provide a welcoming and modern gateway to our school. This dedicated entrance will offer a sense of security and hospitality to students, staff, and visitors, setting the tone for a positive and engaging learning environment.
- 2. Added Space for Future Expansion. The construction of four new classrooms behind Walsingham Hall, which currently houses the library and art room, will provide ample space for future growth and innovation within our school. This expansion will accommodate the evolving needs of our educational programs and ensure that our school remains at the forefront of academic excellence. These rooms will be constructed to match the look of the existing building, essentially doubling its size.
- 3. Consolidation of Students in One Building. Bringing all Prince of Peace Catholic School students under one roof will not only enhance supervision and safety but will also provide protection from inclement weather conditions. This consolidation will foster a sense of unity and community among our students and teachers, promoting collaboration and camaraderie. The expansion plan will also allow the middle school to leave the portable unit, Guadalupe Hall, and join the rest of our school in the newly expanded building.

#### Some Key Benefits to the Parish:

- I. Repurposed Use of Guadalupe Hall. The repurposing of Guadalupe Hall for parish ministry purposes will create opportunities for adult education classes and a new religious education program for preschool-aged students, known as Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. This revitalized space will serve as a hub for spiritual growth and community engagement within our parish.
- 2. Expanded Space for Parish Religious Education Programs. The additional space within the school expansion will be used not just for the school but also for the needs of the Religious Education (RE) department, facilitating Sunday School and Catechism (RCIC) classes. This integration of parish programs into our school facilities will foster collaboration and synergy between our educational and spiritual endeavors.

In essence, the proposed expansion and enhancement of our school and parish facilities embody our unwavering commitment to fostering holistic growth and nurturing the flourishing of our community. As we embark on this transformative journey together, I invite each of you to con-



#### new adult education class


