Letter from our Pastor

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Just a few notes to remember about the survey.

1. Remember, the Catholic Church is not a democracy and this is neither a vote nor a referendum.
2. We're looking for participation and engagement, so even if you're totally uninterested in either project, we need to know that too!
3. Remember that both projects need to be done at some point. The survey is to gauge interest in which to tackle first.
4. This is not a pledge.
5. Your vote is anonymous.
6. The parish is not bound by the results or bound to communicate the results.
7. If you are not a registered parishioner, but want to give to this campaign, we welcome your participation in the fundraising, but this survey is for those who are registered parishioners.
8. The longer we wait to do both projects, the more they will cost, so hopefully we can get them done as soon as we possibly can, and go on to other things.

The Bicentennial Campaign has allowed us to do a number of capital improvement projects that were sorely needed because of deferred maintenance on the buildings while the church was being paid off. That means we have been 25 years spending our energy on the church and what was left undone because of the church. That's a lot of time!

Now, it is time to move forward. We want to do projects that are reachable, necessary and which poise us to be able to better serve those who call Prince of Peace their spiritual home. I'm not going to try to influence your answers to the questions. They need to be spontaneous, true and authentic!

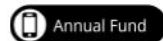

- **Gestation Week 9:** Ten tiny tooth buds are developing with each band of gums. (They will transform into the 20 "baby teeth" that eventually fall out during childhood). The four chambers of the baby's heart have formed. Many moms describe the sound of the heartbeat as similar to the thunder of galloping horses. The heartbeat is twice as fast at an adult's. The mother's body is not only growing a baby, but also the placenta which is attached to the uterus and connected to the baby through the umbilical cord. The placenta is developed to take over most of the critical job of producing hormones what help your baby grow and develop. Psalm 139:14 - *I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made*

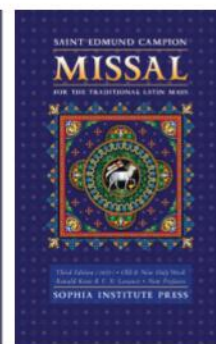
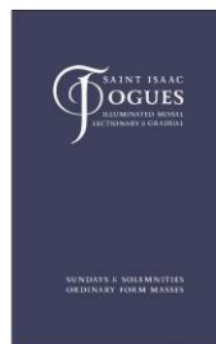

Constantinian Order Announcement

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

The Royal Commission for the United States of the Sacred Military Constantinian Order of Saint George has communicated to Father Christopher Smith that he has been named a Chaplain of Merit for the Order. On 10 April 2024 from Madrid a letter was drafted communicating the news. Father Smith will be invested into the Order in September of this year in the presence of His Royal Highness Pedro de Borbón, the Duke of Calabria and the head of the Royal House of the Bourbons of the Two Sicilies.

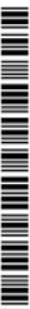


Prince of Peace has already been delighted to have our own Dottor Cavaliere Anatole Upart as a member of this important Order. Father Smith has already been the Chaplain to the Real Circolo Francesco II di Borbone, a pious association advancing devotion to the cause of the illustrious Bourbon monarch and servant of God. Father Smith deepens his commitment to the Order and its spirituality by assuming pastoral care for the members of the Order while continuing to serve as Pastor of Prince of Peace.

The Constantinian Order of Saint George has its remotest origins in the nobility of the Byzantine Empire, but in its present form took shape under the Venetian noble family of Albanian descent, the Angelo Flavio Comneno family. The last male heir of that family transferred the grand mastership of the Order to Francesco Farnese, the Duke of Parma. Their heirs in turn were the Bourbon dynasty. In 1718 Pope Clement XI confirmed the order as a Religious Order of the Catholic Church with the apostolic bull *Militantis Ecclesiae*. Carlo III Borbone became the King of Naples and Sicily as well as the Duke of Parma & Piacenza. The Royal House of Bourbon-Two Sicilies is the cadet branch which ruled Southern Italy and Sicily until Italian Unification in the 19th century. The successor to the House is Prince Pedro, Duke of Calabria, of the Spanish-Neapolitan branch to which Fr Smith is now a chaplain. Prince Pedro is a member of the family of Felipe VI, the King of Spain and is considered by some to also be the current living representative of the House of Stuart. His son and heir, Prince Jaime, the Duke of Noto, is married to Lady Charlotte Lindsey-Bethune. In 2020, the cause for canonization of the last reigning King, Francesco II, was introduced.

Pope St Pius X confirmed a number of privileges for members of the Order in 1910, and Pope Benedict XV consecrated the Church of Santa Croce al Flaminio in Rome as the principal church of the Order. The Order presently undertakes a number of corporate and individual works of charity at both the local and international level as well as cultural events and associations. The Order exists for the spiritual perfection in the Roman Catholic tradition of its members. Although it is not a papal order like the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre or the Sovereign Military Order of Malta, and is not strictly speaking a dynastic order, it is recognized as a Religious Order within the Church.
