# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

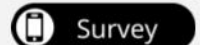
Next Sunday we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, colloquially referred to by its Latin title, *Corpus Christi*, with a Solemn Eucharistic Procession in honor of the Eucharistic King. Our parish has always had a particular devotion to Our Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. The Perpetual Adoration Chapel of Christ the King, a testament of love and presence, has been the secret engine room of the parish for many years. If you are not already a regular adorer or a substitute, I urge every family to consider adopting an hour each week to pray in the chapel. Day in and day out we strive to celebrate the Sacred Liturgy with reverence, dignity and devotion. Adoration is an extension of that most important work on behalf of the People of God which is the Mass.

It is always important that we demonstrate our love for Jesus in the Sacrament, and the Procession of Corpus Christi is a wonderful way to do that. If you go to the 10a Mass, you can join the procession right after Mass. If you go to another Mass, we ask that everyone join on the plaza in front of the church at 11.15a to accompany the King through four stations, with a Gospel reading and Benediction at each station, beautifully prepared by parishioners, all the way back into the church for Solemn Benediction at the end. We need Jesus' blessing, and this is an opportunity to beg His blessing for all of those intentions you hold dear in your heart. It is also an opportunity to make reparation for the blasphemies and outrages against the Blessed Sacrament which are far too common in our time, as well as the lukewarmness and coldness of heart of so many towards the Bread of Heaven for which the angels envy our privilege to receive. Our First Communion and Confirmation kids can wear their gear and have a special place in the procession, as do our members of papal and dynastic orders. Ministries are invited to carry a banner in procession as well and families to carry their special images!

Today, make sure you come back at 1.30p for the potluck in the PAC to celebrate our new deacon! This is a tremendous honor for our parish that the Prince of Peace has chosen Daniel Perry as a new Levite to serve His people from this parish. After his ordination as a deacon, we're not going to get to spend much time with him as he finishes seminary and goes off into the vineyard to work, so let's take advantage of this time now to praise God for this special blessing!

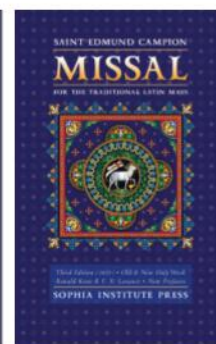
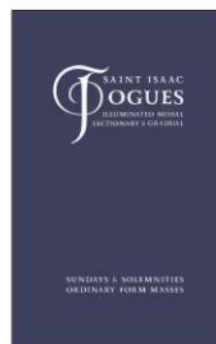

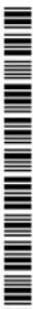
