# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

On Friday, 24 May, our own seminarian Daniel Perry will be ordained to the diaconate at St Joseph's in Columbia. The church is going to be very small for the four men ordained, the clergy, families and friends. He will be with us that weekend, Trinity Sunday, to preach at all the Masses. And we invite everyone to mark their calendars now for a potluck celebration on Sunday, 26 May, at 1.30p in the PAC. It is an important weekend for Daniel, but also for our parish.

Many times people want to give a gift to the newly ordained, but they're not quite sure what to get exactly. Remember that ordinations are, in organizational terms at least, a lot like weddings. Diaconal ordination is followed by priestly ordination by only a few months. In that time, there are invites to be printed and mailed, with RSVPs; receptions to be planned, paid for and executed; copies of the Missal and ritual books for each of the sacraments, and sacramentals, and more books of priestly ministry; cassocks and surplices and albs and amices and cinctures and stoles and chasubles and first Mass vestments to be chosen, ordered and paid for; and all of the tools for ministry that the modern world requires of diocesan clergy: computer, phone, car: the list goes on and on. Also, seminarians and young priests in their ordination phase and early years of ministry are highly mobile. They often move over and over again, and need to be able to not be burdened by so much stuff.

Some ordinands these days actually put together a registry where people can purchase as gifts things they actually need. Remember that these men have not been able to have a job for years they were in the seminary, and their \$250/mo stipend has to cover travel expenses, toiletries, food outside the seminary, and lots of other things besides. So in short order they have a flurry of expenses with little capital saved to fund them. All of this to say that, if you're looking to give a gift this ordination season, please know it is very appreciated, more than you may ever know. But honestly money is more useful than a seventh copy of the Bible, a thirteenth rosary or scapular, or another image of your favorite saint that they then have to carry around from place to place!

I was ordained a deacon in October 2004 and priest in July 2005. My home parish, St Mary's Greenville and my pastor, Fr Newman, were incredibly generous to me during that time. I will always remember that generosity and want to do everything I can to repay their kindness. The people were so kind to me that it made a lasting impression on me and gave me more desire to serve them. We have that opportunity too, so let's do it!

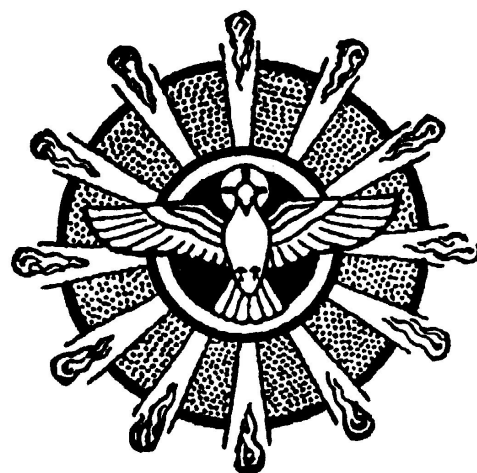

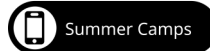
