Meet the Mazelin Family

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Michele's story begins in Columbus, Ohio, where she was baptized Catholic, but raised Baptist. Growing up she enjoyed attending Mass with a friend, seeing her dad's tucked-away "Catholic stuff" (holy cards, rosary, prayer books), and seeking silence and solace late at night in the nearby Catholic church during college. A woman she babysat for suggested Michele consider the Catholic Inquiry class, which started her RCIA journey. She entered the Church in 1988.

Michele earned a BA in International Business at Capital University and an MBA with a Marketing emphasis at The Ohio State University. She met her husband, Dave, when her sister played matchmaker, inviting them to participate in a euchre tournament at her home in 1992. Dave grew up one of eight children in Indianapolis, Indiana. He attended K-12 Catholic schools and was an altar boy before Vatican II. He graduated from Indiana University and spent his career in purchasing. Michele and Dave were married at St. Joseph Cathedral in Columbus in 1993.

Over the following 15 years, they welcomed three daughters and mourned the loss of five children from miscarriages and stillbirths. They have lived in seven states and belonged to a dozen parishes. Michele served in various roles, including lector, children's youth ministry lead-

er, catechist, Vacation Bible School teacher and director, newcomers ministry, and homeschool co-op teacher.



Michele's deep conversion was sparked by volunteering at her first Catholic Vacation Bible School when their oldest was four years old. The program emphasized the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, a truth Michele had not received through RCIA or being Catholic for a decade. She credits that program and priest as pivotal in her faith journey. The following school year coincided with the Great Jubilee of 2000, bringing many graces including their daughter attending the parish kindergarten. Michele experienced the rosary for the first time when it was their turn to pray the traveling giant rosary together as a family. And, she started learning about saints when she volunteered with the parish's Catholic kids club. That fall, they moved to Florida, where Michele participated in Catholic Scripture Study groups and homeschooled their girls, further forming her faith.

Michele and Dave had an eye on Greenville after reading a 2005 National Catholic Register article touting the area's Catholic orthodoxy. Although they toured the city and Catholic parishes and schools at that time, it was another decade before God opened the door to move here.

The Mazelins have lived in Greenville for nine years, joining POP upon their arrival, making it their longest spiritual home. Michele has been active in the POP homeschool group, served on the POPCS Catholic Identity Committee, provided funeral refreshments through the bereavement committee, and chaired the Marian Art Show. Dave has added muscle, laying sod, moving furniture, setting up events, and working on the Mary Garden. Their youngest, Julia, recently graduated from POPCS, where she attended the past two years. The Mazelins describe POPCS as an incredible family where Julia thrived academically and grew spiritually.

They love the assurance of staying settled in Greenville since Dave retired from GE last year. He now enjoys being a selfemployed handyman and boating any chance he gets. Michele works as Communications Manager for the nonprofit, Support After Abortion. The Mazelins cherish the community they have found at Prince of Peace, feeling truly at home in the parish.





legion of mary

Did you know our Blessed Mother has an army? It is called the Legion of Mary. It was founded in Ireland in 1921. It is the largest lay apostolic organization in the Catholic Church with over 3 million members worldwide. Members do active and auxiliary works. 
