#### Trish Hamel's Camino de Santiago Pilgrimage

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Ultreia et Suseia! Let's Go Further – Let's Go Higher!

There is an ancient pilgrimage across Europe with multiple paths that lead the faithful across France, Portugal, Italy, and Spain. The Pilgrimage is known as the "Camino de Santiago", and its many routes converge on the magnificent Cathedral in Santiago de Compostela, Spain, where the remains of St. James the Apostle are buried. In recent years, the pilgrimage has gained popularity among the faithful and others, who make the trek for countless reasons. For myself, the Camino de Santiago called to me first in a whisper five years ago, and gradually became louder and more persistent. I knew it was time to go and that the time was now, in 2024, before I reach my next major milestone birthday. A group of four joined me on the journey.

Our modest band of pilgrims decided to walk a portion of the "Caminho Portugues", the Portuguese Camino Central route. The route stretches from Lisbon to Santiago - 643 km - and takes 30 days to walk, a time commitment that no one in our group was able to make. The decision was to start from Valenca, Portugal and walk to Santiago from there – a distance of (merely) 124 km. On June 5, our small group gathered in Valenca, Portugal, a border town that is the site of a medieval (12th century) fort, where we spent the night before our first day on the Camino in an apartment within the walls of the ancient fort. It is common for this journey to be divided into six segments from Valenca, and we followed the example of thousands who have traveled this road before us and made the journey in six days. On June 11, we completed the Camino and arrived at the Cathedral in Santiago, tears streaming down our faces and pure joy in our hearts. Our total distance walked was 124 km.



While the mechanics of the journey are a necessary part of telling of the experience, they are the least important part. What those facts cannot convey is the meaning of this journey and the importance of what we discovered about God, ourselves, and each other. For my part, I reached out to friends and acquaintances alike for prayer requests and intentions which I recorded on pages in a journal as I received them. Each step of the road, I carried those intentions with me. There is a tradition on the Camino that a Pilgrim picks up a rock to carry with them on their journey; a rock that represents emotional weight or burdens within a Pilgrim's own life, or those of the individuals for whom they are praying. As I passed mile (km) markers along the way, I would place one rock upon the marker, and pick up another, and each one represented an individual in my prayer journal. Through the most challenging times, like the day when the temperature was 89 sunny degrees, the walk was 20 km (12 miles) with an altitude gain of 240 meters, it felt that I was sharing the burden of another individual's suffering, yet I have never felt such joy.

It is said that the first step in a pilgrimage is the one from your front door. When you take that step, I wish you Bom Caminho and a fruitful journey!
