# Meet the Moynihan Family

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

The golden thread of the Moynihan family story is Catholic community. College community at DeSales University pursuing a BA in Human Resources was where Scott’s faith really blossomed. For Kathleen, it was the community of a High school youth group that she credits for her growth in relationship with the Lord. As parents, the answer for community for the good of their children meant moving 10 hours from their Pennsylvania home. They first learned about Greenville in an article on strong Catholic communities and soon after found themselves exploring the area for the right church and school home. A meeting with Fr Christopher Smith and former Principal Steve Cunningham sealed the deal alongside mutual friends introducing them to parishioners, the Richardson family. Since their 2023 move, the Moynihans shared that despite the hardships of distance from family, they’ve gained a deeper faith through beautiful liturgy, strong Catholic friendships and a great school for their children. And, the expression of community tied them most recently to uniting in prayer for the Cox family as their friend Adam came into full communion with the church this Easter. “Everyone we meet here seems to desire to grow in their faith life,” said Kathleen. Scott has learned a lot in the Marian Catechist courses offered at the parish. And, the family has received beautiful insights from their two older sons through altar serving at Mass.



Scott and Kathleen are a Catholic Match success story virtually shrinking the whopping 2 miles distance between them in the same town. “It was love at first sight,” said Kathleen. They met in April 2010, married in July 2011 and share 5 glorious children—Madeline, Jack, Ryan, Owen and Connor. Kathleen graduated with a BS in Math and Secondary Education from the University of Scranton. Then, she earned a MA in Theology Christian Ministry from Franciscan University. Scott was honored by his Pennsylvania employer with an offer to continue his Hospital-based HR job remotely—a God wink in the midst of their feasibility assessment to move. For fun, the family loves swimming, playing board games and biking.

It can be difficult to move. And, take a while to make a new place into a home. The Moynihans credit the ease of their transition to getting involved. Scott serves on the “Dad Squad” of the parish school and Kathleen has just accepted the role of Catholic Identity Chair after being a committee member in 2023-24. “Our advice would be to identify your passion and see how you can use it to serve the Lord and parish community. There are so many ministries to get involved with and to serve His people.”

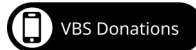

- **Gestation Week 15:** The baby is forming taste buds, and nerves begin connecting them to the brain. By 20 weeks, your baby's taste buds will be fully formed. During pregnancy, molecules of what you eat pass through Mom's bloodstream and make it into your amniotic fluid. But your baby doesn't taste what you're eating. Your baby's legs are growing longer than their arms now and they can move all of their joints and limbs. Your baby is moving constantly though you can't feel it yet. Your baby looks like a little person with eyelids, eyebrows, eyelashes, nails, hair, and well-defined fingers and toes. Your baby is sucking a thumb, yawning, stretching and making faces! Psalm 139:14 - *I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made*

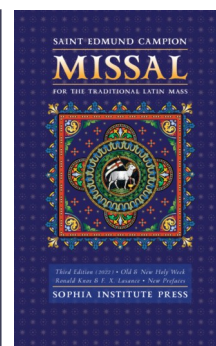
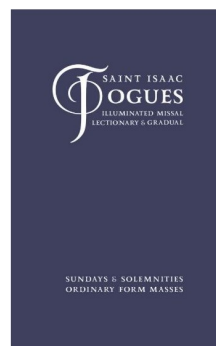

Notification Letter

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Beginning July 1, 2024, Bishop Jacques Fabre-Jeune has decreed that the Diocese of Charleston will implement the VIRTUS® Programs as the new comprehensive safe environment training for adults. The adult training, *Protecting God's Children*® program will be the official training for employees and volunteers, while the *Empowering God's Children*® Program will continue to be the safe environment training curriculum for children. The VIRTUS Online database is an online portal that provides participants with the ability to maintain online safe environment accounts, register for and complete online training, access important documentation for acknowledgement purposes and the ability to submit a background check.

The initial training program, *Protecting God's Children* educates adults on how to become better protectors of youth from child sexual abuse. Participants become more aware of the context and issues surrounding child abuse, the methods and means by which offenders take advantage of others and the ways in which abuse affects victims, their families, and the community. Participants are empowered with best practices involving boundaries, action items and five steps to both prevent and best respond to child sexual abuse. The Diocese of Charleston will also utilize various refresher training from VIRTUS on topics related to preventing and addressing the abuse of children and the vulnerable.

Employees and volunteers who have already completed a safe environment training, to date, will have access to these previous training records within the VIRTUS database, BUT will not be required to complete the initial *Protecting God's Children* training until their current training expires, per the current diocesan policy.

Conversely, for new employees and volunteers, who have not yet completed any safe environment measures, they will be able to create a new account and complete online training directly through the VIRTUS site.

More information will be forthcoming from your safe environment site administrator, who is also your immediate contact for questions relating to accessing your account, any previous training records, updating existing accounts with relevant contact information and recertification trainings and background checks.

We are pleased to be partnering with VIRTUS (<https://www.virtus.org>) and look forward to working together to make our churches, schools, homes and communities a safer place for all of God's children.
