Meet the Carter Family

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

You've heard of a Roman Catholic, but have you ever heard of a Roaming Roman Catholic? Parishioner Megan Reichert Carter coined the phrase due to her journey through many of the parishes in Greenville over her lifetime. Megan, her husband Mike, and their son Lawson became members of Prince of Peace in June 2022.

Megan moved to Greenville with her parents, Don and Marilyn Reichert, and her younger sister, Erin, from New Jersey in 1986. The family joined St. Elizabeth Anne Seaton in Mauldin, where Megan made her first communion. Shortly after, the Reicherts joined a new Catholic mission in Simpsonville called the Maxwell Pointe Catholic Community, later renamed St. Mary Magdalene. It was at St. Mary Magdalene that Megan's servant heart blossomed. By age 14, she had already taken on significant roles within the church, serving as a Eucharistic Minister, Lecturer, and had a weekly holy hour in the adoration chapel. She was also one of the first teen members of LifeTeen and a singer in their "Life Band." Her early achievements in the Catholic community set her on a path of continued service and leadership.

After college, Megan returned to Greenville and joined her family, who had moved to St. Mary's parish downtown. She sang in the choir and helped with the high school youth group there. Through her involvement with the youth group, she was asked to help lead the new high school youth group at Our Lady of the Rosary. During this time, Megan lived in Greer and, on her weekends "off" from her parish duties, attended mass at Prince of Peace, which sparked her initial love for the parish.



Having met so many young adult Catholics through her "roaming" from parish to parish, Megan created the Facebook group "Carolina Catholic Young Adults." The group grew to over 200 members from parishes around the Upstate and held monthly social events. In 2012, the group became part of the larger diocesan young adult group, Lucis Via.

Megan and Mike were married at St. Mary's and moved to Chapin, SC, in 2016. While Mike is not Catholic, he has supported raising their son in the faith. When it came time for Lawson to start school, the couple decided to move back to Greenville for the excellent Catholic schools. They chose Prince of Peace for the traditional liturgy and Fr. Smith's active role in the parish and school life.

The Carters love Prince of Peace Church and School and the friends they have made here. The "Roaming Roman" roams no longer as Megan and her family see themselves staying at POP for the foreseeable future.

Megan graduated from Appalachian State University in 2003 with a Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance and a Bachelor of Science in Communications. She is the Life Insurance Specialist for Consolidated Planning out of Charlotte, NC. She served in the choir and is an active member of the Catholic Identity Committee with the parish school.

Mike is from Columbus, IN, and graduated from Indiana University in 1999 with a BA in Microbiology. He is a Lieutenant Colonel and Jumpmaster with the Army Reserve, having served four tours of duty as a signal officer in Afghanistan in the early 2000s. He is also the area director of government orthopedic sales for Acumed.

Lawson is a rising second grader at Prince of Peace Catholic School. He loves swimming, hiking, airplanes, and all things military.

If you homeschool your child(ren) and are teaching religion at home, please fill out a Homeschool RE Registration Form and turn it into Maria Barontini. This serves as a record for sacramental preparation and is needed YEARLY. The parish needs records for two full years for First Holy Communion AND two years of records for Confirmation preparation. Please do not come to the parish office expecting your child to receive a sacrament immediately without proper records and attendance at mandatory sacramental events/ meetings. The Homeschool RE Registration Form outlines the requirements for each sacrament for our homeschooling families. ALL First Holy Communion YEAR 2 and Confirmation YEAR 2 registration forms must be turned in prior to the yearly December deadline for a child to participate in a spring sacrament.


