Meet the Hernandez Family

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Kristina fell more in love with her faith while sketching churches in Rome, with her husband on the dance floor, with St Michael and St Padre Pio through her mother's devotion and with herself on a mountain top. Born and raised in New Jersey, Kristina's path was anything but predictable. Although she pursued a degree in Computer Information Systems at her parents' insistence, her heart was always set on making a difference in the world—an ambition that led her down an unexpected, yet profoundly impactful, road.

Kristina's dream was to run for office and create meaningful change. She found her calling in public relations, a field where she could influence and shape narratives in ways that resonated with her desire to make a difference. Her career took off when she worked on a governor's race in West Virginia, igniting a passion for public service and communication that has continued to flourish.

But Kristina's story doesn't stop at her professional achievements. After graduating from American University, where she particularly cherished the time she spent studying



abroad in Rome, Kristina experienced a reversion in her faith. Serving as a Core Leader for Life Teen in New Jersey played a pivotal role in rekindling her relationship with God, too. Her time in Rome, which included unforgettable experiences like meeting Pope John Paul II and attending Mass at the Vatican, deepened her faith and inspired her to nearly complete a graduate degree in Moral Theology at Christendom. Her motive was clear: to understand her faith so profoundly that she could pass it on to her children, especially the most challenging aspects.

It was in Alexandria, Virginia, where Kristina met El Salvadorian-born Roberto, the man who would become her partner in life began as her salsa partner! It was a fitting metaphor for the balance Kristina credits Roberto bringing to her life. The Hernandez family has called Prince of Peace Catholic Church their spiritual home for the past decade. After discerning among several parishes, they were drawn to the beauty, reverence, and welcoming atmosphere created by Fr Smith. Here, they have found not just a church, but a community that feels like home.

Kristina and Roberto have two daughters, both of whom are homeschooled. Their eldest is entering 8th grade, and their youngest is about to start 4th grade. Kristina is deeply committed to providing her daughters with a rich and fulfilling education, one that goes beyond academics to include life experiences and spiritual growth.

This commitment to life experiences is a direct reflection of Kristina's own life philosophy, especially after the tragic loss of her mother to breast cancer when Kristina was just 26. Vowing to create as many adventures with her daughters as possible, Kristina frequently takes them on hiking and travel adventures. Some of their favorite trails include Alum Cave to Mt. LeConte, the South Kaibab Trail at the Grand Canyon, and the challenging Grandfather Mountain trail with its ladders. On Tuesdays, you can find the oldest daughter taking part in Fidelis, a mentoring program for girls to grow in virtue.


