There are two main types of clergy: secular and religious. Religious clergy live in community and take vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. Secular clergy live in the world and take a vow of obedience to the bishop and a promise of celibacy. The communal life of the apostles always inspired even secular clergy to come together in communities. The word *canon* comes from the Greek word for rule. Priests would often gather in communities and live according to a rule of life. Communities of religious priests and brothers called canons regular grew up, especially in the early Middle Ages. But often cathedrals would have a community of secular canons. In many places the chapter of canons assisted the Bishop in the governance of the diocese. Cathedral canons often administered the cathedral as the seat of the bishop and made important decisions for the life of the diocese. Many basilicas that were important churches had chapters of canons, such as the four major basilicas of Rome and many minor basilicas throughout the world. There were even smaller churches with chapters called collegiate chapters. In all of them, a communal life centered around worship, pastoral care and administration made canonical life a unique way of living out a clerical spirituality.

From time to time, bishops designated priests as honorary canons, because of their connection with the life of the diocese, even if it was not a diocese to which they belonged. It indicated a visible link with the communion of the Church, and is a responsibility more than a dignity. In the United States, chapters of canons were never established. But in other parts of the world, they remain even today vibrant aspects of ecclesial life.

The Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Istanbul, Turkey, was built in 1846 by Gaspere Frossati under Archbishop Julien Hillereau. It was often referred to by its French name, Saint-Ésprit, because of the numerous Levantines who worshiped there who spoke French and Turkish. In 1908, the cathedral was put under a special relationship with St Peter’s Basilica in Rome. In 1909, the Cathedral was named a Minor Basilica. The canons of the cathedral were secular clergy who assisted in the life of the Latin Apostolic Vicariate of Constantinople. In 1989, pastoral care of the cathedral came under the Salesians of Don Bosco, religious priests, as diocesan clergy soon became inoperative in the vicariate, and so the chapter of canons became practically defunct.

Monsignor Massimiliano Palinuro sought to revive the chapter of canons and with the unanimous support of the presbyteral council of the vicariate, Father Christopher Smith was enrolled among the honorary canons of the Cathedral-Basilica. When now-Canon Smith is in Istanbul, he has a special role to play with the Bishop and in the life of the Cathedral, which was his spiritual home when he studied there on sabbatical. He will receive the *mozzetta*, a shoulder cape in the purple color *paonazzo* with buttons and trims in the reddish color *cremisi*, which is put over the rochet as part of choir dress, and a cassock with buttons and trims in the purple color *paonazzo*, indicating his belonging to the chapter of canons.

This is not a personal honor for Father Smith but a recognition of the tremendous generosity with which Prince of Peace has sacrificially collaborated in the mission of the Church in Turkey, and as such it is a grace for all who call Prince of Peace their spiritual home. It is a real tangible link between our parish and the Church in Turkey. Canon Smith will be installed as an honorary canon of the Cathedral of Istanbul on the Solemnity of Christ the King, 24 November 2024. He will continue as Pastor of Prince of Peace, of course, but with this special relationship to the Church in Turkey.
