new diocesan policy on weapons

It is the new policy of the Diocese of Charleston, effective immediately, that there are only two types of individuals allowed to carry a weapon or firearm (concealed or open carry) on Diocesan property:

1) active-duty law enforcement under the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act or 2) SLED licensed employees of a SLED certified security company during their Documented Duty Period with a security company and during a contracted agreement only. Authorized individuals shall not serve in any role for a parish, school or other diocesan entity during their Documented Duty Period.

Gestation Week 28: Your baby's eyesight is developing, which may enable them to sense light filtering in from the outside. They can blink and their eyelashes have grown in. Other senses of hearing, smell and touch are developed and functional. During this trimester, the brain will triple in weight. The cerebrum will develop deep, convoluted grooves that provide extra surface area without taking up more room in the skull. Your baby's autonomic nervous system(which controls involuntary movements) is taking on new tasks. It is starting to control your baby's body temperature and managing rhythmic breathing movements, which develop and strengthen your baby's lungs.
