# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends,

Next Sunday at the 10a we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Palestine, the patronal feast of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre, and at the 12N the traditional feast of Christ the King in the Extraordinary Form. The last weekend of October has become a special time of feast for our parish community.

The Holy Land is very special to all Christians, as well as Jews and Muslims. The relationship between them has gone through periods of relatively peaceful coexistence and moments of outright slaughter. The modern idea of religious freedom is essentially a Western concept developed under a very Christian idea of the inviolability of conscience, but even that is a development within Christianity. To seek it out anachronistically in the past is a futile exercise. To expect it to magically occur today is naïve.

As we see this most recent cycle of violence take lives and destroy cultures, I have been thinking a lot about the relationship between violence and religion. Many atheists and agnostics today insist that religion is at the root of all wars, or at least the overwhelming majority of them. Are certain religions intrinsically prone to violence, or are episodes like we are seeing now merely adjacent to the cultures that are shaped by them?

Karen Armstrong is a celebrated writer with a unique background who set out to answer that question based on the data of history. She grew up Catholic in the UK and became a religious sister. While in the community, she experienced physical and emotional abuse that set her on a journey that led her out of the convent to find healing. Today she is one of the most read authors on religious history, and no longer identifies as a believing Christian. Yet her scholarship seeks to place the history of religion in its broader context.


*Fields of Blood: Religion and the History of Violence* is a very fascinating book. She locates questions about the violence of particular religious traditions in the context of comparative history. Why is this important? Often controversialists and amateur armchair commentators make sweeping generalisations about a particular faith or a specific event without being able to see a wider picture. Armstrong's careful analysis avoids the easy answers and editorializing that often creates more heat than light in these discussions. There were many events here in history that I never heard of in my life, and it also made me realise my own deficit in certain aspects of world history that inspires me to learn more.

Armstrong is not writing as a theologian from a specific religious tradition, but as a social scientist. Ordinarily I would not recommend a book written by an apostate, for obvious reasons. But the toxic environment in which religious questions are poisoning public discourse demands that believing Christians seek the truth, not just about the fullness of divine revelation revealed in His Church but also the reality of history. I have been familiar with her work since my high school history teacher gave me one of her books as a graduation present. I very much found this book challenged many assumptions I did not know I had, and also provided a new framework with which to form my own thoughts about so many conflicts currently threatening not only the Holy Land but our entire world.

Let us pray for the peace of Jerusalem!


