Letter from our Pastor



An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends,

This week I will be privileged to help lead a pilgrimage to Greece and Turkey with some of our own parishioners as well as parishioners from North Carolina from my friend Father Jason Barone's parish. The Turkey part is literally just the Blessed Mother's house in Ephesus, but I will spend a few days after the pilgrimage there for my installation as a canon of the Cathedral of Istanbul. The Greece part is something I am very much looking forward to. I have been to Athens and seen the Parthenon, but not much else. Like when I went on pilgrimage to the Holy Land, I could never read the Gospels the same again, my hope is that the Epistles will come alive in a new way for me reading them in the footsteps of Saint Paul.

One of the places I look forward to seeing the most is Thessaloniki. This vibrant and ancient city has had a fascinating history. Last year I read a book by Mark Mazower called Salonica: City of Ghosts — Christians, Muslims and Jews 1430-1950. Like Istanbul, Salonika, as the city was known to the Ottoman Empire, was a multiethnic, pluri-religious society which had a cosmopolitan culture and incredible trade center. It was also a place where those very different traditions intermingled in a way very unlike many other parts of the Empire. There were a lot of eccentric personalities, heroes and villains to the story. But it is also a story of tragedy. Like Smyrna/Izmir, a flourishing civilization with much to teach us today was reduced to rubble by hatred.

During November, we reflect on the theological truth that Christ is the true Sovereign, not only of our hearts, but of civil society. We also think about and pray for the dead, whose faith is known to God alone, and the need to intercede for the dead, not only our loved ones, but also those who have no one to pray for them. Hatred and violence have devastating consequences for those who pay the ultimate price for it and for those left behind. The legacy of those cycles cause deep trauma and dynamics that are hard to heal from and escape to a healthier, holier life. And when we use religion as a pretext for hatred and violence, or passive-aggressively instrumentalise faith for very human goals of domination and subjugation, we obscure the goodness of God by the infection of sin.

We need to release the past, embrace the present with all of its joys and sorrows, and develop hope in the future of love. That is our common goal for November. I pray that on pilgrimage I may be able to do the same in my own life, in the places that are crucial for revelation and history. But the same God is approachable no matter where we are.

Gestation Week 33: The bones in your baby's skull aren't fused together, which allows them to move and slightly overlap. This makes it easier for your baby to fit through the birth canal (the channel formed by your cervix, vagina, and vulva). The pressure on their head during birth is so intense that many babies are born with a pointy head. The skull bones don't entirely fuse until early adulthood, so they can grow as your baby's brain and other tissue expands during infancy and childhood. Your little one is rapidly losing that wrinkled look. The baby's skin is less red and transparent - it is becoming soft and smooth as your little one plumps up in preparation for birth. It is getting snug in your womb, so your baby isn't doing as many somersaults, but the amount of movement you feel should remain the same. After your baby moves to a head-down position in preparation for birth, you may feel kicks in new places, like underneath your ribs on one side or the other. 


