Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends.

This Saturday from 8a-12p we are having a seminar which is probably not the way you would like to spend a Saturday morning, but I really encourage you to consider it. As November looms near, the Church directs our thoughts to the Last Things, to the end of our lives and the end of the world. How do I make arrangements for my will, funeral and burial? What end of life options are open and which are closed to Catholics? You don't just die and that is the end of it. Prior planning can make your loved ones' lives so much easier when you are gone.

One thing which is new this year is that we are happy to announce that there are two other opportunities for you to remember Prince of Peace in your final arrangements. People often leave the parish money in their wills to some current need or to operating or capital needs. We have been blessed to receive a number of bequests of this type over the years and we are always grateful for them.

The Diocese has now given us the green light to establish a possibility to receive gifts that keep on giving. We have founded two Endowments: one for the parish and one for the school. These are gifts, not for the present, but for the future. At the seminar, you will get more information on these and so many other useful bits of information. More information on the endowments will be coming. We encourage you to think of Prince of Peace's future as you plan for the future as well.

I Corinthians 3.9-14: We are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward.

As God's fellow workers in the vineyard, we can reap many rewards by giving gifts that keep on giving for the future. Come on Saturday and learn more about all of those end of life issues and how your resurrection in Christ can change the future for so many people!


