


An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Next week is an historical occasion within the celebration of our 50 years as a parish. Daniel Perry will be ordained a priest of Jesus Christ on Friday of this week in Charleston and offer a Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving on Pentecost Sunday at 10a. We ask that all of you attend this Mass to support our new priest! There will be an amazing party afterwards, because this is really something to celebrate. Come receive your first blessing and kiss the freshly chrismated palms of the new priest and go feast! The 12p Mass will be postponed until 5p as a Low Mass, so remember there is no Noon Mass next week. Also, if you are thinking of a gift, which is highly appropriate, a nice heartfelt letter and cash is the way to go! An ordination is like a wedding, and so there are lots of expenses that the new priest incurs, so be generous.

This weekend, one of our home grown seminarians, Jack Kauffman, will move into the rectory for a summer experience of gentlemanly clerical living. The Diocese has asked him to take a secular job to gain real-world work experience, which I think is a great opportunity. He has been assigned to serve at St. Anthony's on Sundays. When I was a seminarian on summer assignment, I always had families inviting me over to their house for dinner or out for lunch. My dance card was always full and it gave me such a wonderful insight into the life! So please, please, reach out to him after Mass and give him your contact information and an invite. It means more than you know.



Father Perry will have a brief period of rest before taking up his first assignment as Parochial Vicar at St Gregory the Great in Bluffton, the second largest parish in the Diocese. There are a lot of retirees down there, so I told him he will memorise the anointing and funeral rites really fast, but there is also a flourishing Hispanic community, a large parish school and the St John Paul II High School nearby. He will serve under Msgr Ronald Cellini, who was actually my second pastor as a priest, and I know that the new priest will have a lot of good priestly work to keep him busy. So spend time with him now because he will be busy and far away!



### 3rd Quarter FY25 Financial Statements Note

The Year-to-Date (Y-T-D) Offertory is now tracking to Budget, although slightly behind the previous year because of the quarterly timing difference of Easter. All Other Revenue is now ahead of Budget, but slightly behind the previous year. Our Parish Expenses continue to be managed and show that we are ahead of Budget at the bottom line. The net result is showing a \$128K Y-T-D surplus and a Y-T-D favorable variance to Budget of \$73K for the 3rd Quarter of our fiscal year. The balance sheet shows that we have withdrawn \$100,000 from our savings account to help fund our Y-T-D Capital Expenditures. Our Y-T-D Capital Expenditures are \$278K as we have completed the St. Joseph Workshop (maintenance building), the pew and kneeler projects, combined with various other infrastructure improvements. These projects were funded from our recently ended 5-year Bicentennial Campaign, savings withdrawals combined with our operating surpluses. We believe we are now on track to complete the fiscal year meeting our Offertory Budget forecast while completing many capital projects throughout this past fiscal year. As always, we sincerely thank you all for your continued financial contributions without which we cannot achieve so many wonderful things for the parish and the school.
