#### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

As a Diocese, we see a significant drop-off in participation among young people after Confirmation. But in truth, Confirmation is not the finish line—it's the *starting point* of a deeper, more mature walk with Christ. That journey requires ongoing effort, curiosity, and above all, a lifelong commitment to learning.

As Catholics, we believe that faith is not static. It's a living, growing relationship with God that must be nurtured throughout our entire lives. Just as our minds and bodies continue to develop, so too must our spiritual lives. The Catechism reminds us, "Faith seeks understanding" (CCC 158). This means we are called—at every age and stage of life—to keep asking questions, seeking truth, and deepening our understanding of God, Scripture, and Church teaching. Lifelong learning is not optional for Christians—it's essential to our spiritual growth.

Think about it: Would you trust a doctor who stopped learning after medical school? Would you want a teacher who never read another book after college? Our faith deserves the same dedication. The saints understood this well—St. Jerome spent his life studying Scripture, St. Thomas Aquinas never stopped exploring theology, and St. Teresa of Avila continued growing in prayer and mystical understanding well into her later years.

All parishioners of Prince of Peace are invited to grow in wisdom, knowledge, and understanding—three vital Gifts of the Holy Spirit we received at Confirmation. Throughout the Gospels, we see Jesus constantly teaching, inviting His disciples into an ongoing relationship of formation and growth. The Church, in her wisdom, continues that mission by calling all of us to deeper conversion and continued learning.

To our adults: You have so much wisdom to share! Invite our high school and young adults to your Bible studies, discussion groups, and ministries. You may be surprised by what their youthful insights bring—and they will benefit greatly from seeing strong, faith-filled Catholic adult role models living out their faith with joy and authenticity.

To our former Confirmation students: Your journey is just beginning! Keep studying your faith with the same energy you bring to everything else. Connect with other Catholic teens who share your values. Come to our awesome CYO starting this fall. Join one of our adult classes. Ask me for book recommendations—and if I don't have one on a topic you're curious about, I'll connect you with someone who does. The more you learn, the more equipped you'll be to live out your faith with confidence and clarity in our complex world.

Many parents rediscover the richness of of their childhood faith when they begin teaching their own children about God. Some who had drifted away find themselves reconnecting with Christ alongside their child's religious education journey. As Jesus tells us in *Matthew 18:3*, "Amen, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." We are all called to learn with the humility, openness, and wonder of a child—never assuming we've "graduated" from the faith or have nothing left to discover about our infinitely loving God.

Whether it's joining an adult Bible study, reading a spiritual classic, diving into a Catholic podcast, or exploring one of the many classes and resources offered here at Prince of Peace—there are countless ways to nourish your growing faith.

Very soon, we'll be introducing a new resource for our entire parish family, and we encourage everyone—especially our recent Confirmation students—to engage with it both at home and here at the parish. Stay tuned for more information and a guest speaker announcement this fall. We're excited to share this opportunity for growth with you all.

This week, ask yourself: What am I doing to keep my faith alive, informed, and growing? How can I take one small step forward in my spiritual journey?

The pilgrimage will be offered in prayer for **Sister Philip Marie Burle**, and special intentions, including prayers for life, expectant mothers, and the faithful departed, will be incorporated throughout.

This thoughtfully planned journey includes round-trip airfare from Newark, hotel accommodations, most meals, entrance fees, ground transportation, and an English-speaking guide. It's designed to be spiritually enriching while also accommodating the practical needs of travelers. Participants should be prepared for moderate walking and moments of profound encounter with Scripture and tradition.

2025-26 Religious Education Forms are now available in the Parish Office or by emailing <a href="Maria.barontini@princeofpeacetaylors.org">Maria.barontini@princeofpeacetaylors.org</a>.

Please register early. Classes will begin 17 August, with a parent meeting in the PAC after dropping students off in their classrooms. One parent MUST attend the meeting per family.

If you chose to homeschool your child(ren) and are teaching religion at home, please fill out a Homeschool RE Registration Form and turn it into Maria Barontini. This serves as a record for sacramental preparation and is needed YEARLY. The parish needs records for two full years for First Holy Communion AND two years of records for Confirmation preparation. Please do not come to the parish office expecting your child to receive a sacrament immediately without proper records and attendance at mandatory sacramental events/meetings. The homeschool RE Registration Form outlines the requirements for each sacrament for our homeschooling families. ALL First Holy Communion YEAR 2 and Confirmation YEAR 2 registration forms must be turned in prior to the yearly December deadline for a child to participate in a spring sacrament.
