Dear Parishioners,

Since January 2020, our parish has completed more than \$1.5 million in capital improvements to maintain and enhance our campus. These projects — ranging from upgraded campus lighting and enhanced or replaced HVAC systems to the construction of our new maintenance building, St Joseph's Workshop — reflect our shared commitment to stewarding the physical home of our faith.

Notably, significant investments were made in **campus HVAC** systems (\$389,305), Ecclesiastical **Beautification** (\$302,833), Campus Lighting (\$235,328), all while ensuring both functionality and reverence in our worship spaces. Every project has been thoughtfully prioritized to serve our growing needs while preserving the beauty and safety of our church and school.

Looking ahead, we have identified over \$400K in capital needs for our campus. While these projects exclude the school expansion and pipe organ projects, they do include critical building structural improvements, remaining HVAC upgrades, and enhancements to lighting, appliances, and audio/visual systems. These needs have been carefully assessed to ensure we are preparing our facilities for future generations.

We are deeply grateful for your continued generosity, which has made all of this possible. As we move forward, we ask for your prayerful consideration in supporting the completion of these projects — investments that not only sustain our parish life today but build a legacy of faith for tomorrow.



This 10-day pilgrimage will immerse travelers in the sacred geography of our faith, offering daily Mass, guided visits to holy sites, and time for prayer and reflection.

Pilgrims will visit Bethlehem, Nazareth, the Sea of Galilee, and Jerusalem—praying at the Church of the Nativity, renewing wedding vows at Cana, walking the Via Dolorosa, and celebrating Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. The itinerary also includes Mount Tabor, the Mount of Beatitudes, the Jordan River, and even a chance to float in the Dead Sea. The pilgrimage will be offered in prayer for **Sister Philip Marie Burle**, and special intentions, including prayers for life, expectant mothers, and the faithful departed, will be incorporated throughout.

This thoughtfully planned journey includes round-trip airfare from Newark, hotel accommodations, most meals, entrance fees, ground transportation, and an English-speaking guide. It's designed to be spiritually enriching while also accommodating the practical needs of travelers. Participants should be prepared for moderate walking and moments of profound encounter with Scripture and tradition.

Please register early. Classes will begin 17 August, with a parent meeting in the PAC after dropping students off in their classrooms. One parent MUST attend the meeting per family.

If you chose to homeschool your child(ren) and are teaching religion at home, please fill out a Homeschool RE Registration Form and turn it into Maria Barontini. This serves as a record for sacramental preparation and is needed YEARLY. The parish needs records for two full years for First Holy Communion AND two years of records for Confirmation preparation. Please do not come to the parish office expecting your child to receive a sacrament immediately without proper records and attendance at mandatory sacramental events/meetings. The homeschool RE Registration Form outlines the requirements for each sacrament for our homeschooling families. ALL First Holy Communion YEAR 2 and Confirmation YEAR 2 registration forms must be turned in prior to the yearly December deadline for a child to participate in a spring sacrament.
