Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

I know nobody wants to hear what I did on my summer vacation, but do permit to share a few anecdotes about a couple of places I visited and why. The island of Cyprus is divided into the Republic of Cyprus, which is Greek speaking and mostly Orthodox, and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, which is a country only recognized by Turkey, and is mostly Muslim. Cyprus has a fascinating history, but I wanted to visit after I read Elif Shafak's novel *The Island of Missing Trees*, which fictionally represents many true stories of how Turkish and Greek lovers and friends were brutally ripped apart forever by war.

In the city of Famagusta is a ghost town called Varosha, that until 1974 was one of the most celebrated resort towns for locals as well as the rich and famous in the world. Then war happened and the town to this day remains as it was then, but empty. The UN controls it, and I thought I was going to get shot for taking a picture of the UN sign at the checkpoint there. Lesson learned. You can see the signs in Turkish, English, French, Greek and Armenian of hotels, shops and clubs. Now all abandoned, and falling apart. It is one of the creepiest places I have ever been, but I think it stands as a monument to how hate can ruin the good. Imagine one day you go to Myrtle Beach for a vacation with your family, like you have for generations, and then from one day to the next it is turned into a war zone, never to recover?

I then made my way to Ayvalik in Turkey. In 1920, there were about 60,000 people in this charming fishing village, mostly Greeks. The city was filled with churches and lovely homes. The European powers, along with America, had what they thought was a brilliant idea: to end the conflict between Greece and Turkey, just deport millions of people at one time to opposite sides of the Aegean. The entire population of the town was forced out, which then became an economic disaster because it was responsible for a significant amount of olive oil production. 4,500 Greeks were forced back to keep the olive oil running again, but they were not allowed to go back to their old homes. And just a few years later, they were deported as well. Beautiful churches were emptied of their icons and become storage houses or mosques, and some rare few became museums in a late attempt to salvage some of the artistic patrimony of a people that vanished.

In the early decades of the 20th century, world leaders and superpowers forcefully migrated millions of people in various parts of the globe thinking that was enough to defuse conflicts. Nationalisms of various kinds grew to such a fever pitch that the multiethnic, pluri-religious empires of centuries past disintegrated in a frenzy of ethnic cleansing and violence in which millions died as a result of starvation and violence. Did the strategy work? Did it produce world peace? No, it impoverished cultures and destroyed civilizations.

What is so sad, it is still going on today. And there is no reason to think that it couldn't also happen here. When we give up on people and think there is no path forward to peace, we short circuit the path to a better future. Why is it so hard for us to treat each other like humans? My visits to these places were not just to be a tourist and get some good photos. They were a meditation on human suffering and violence, and what it means to be a decent human being.




national day of remembrance
