# Letter from our Pastor

## An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The Cross is at the center of our altar in the church, because the Mystery of the Cross is at the center of liturgy and life for the Christian.

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. **I Corinthians 1:18** 

The Incarnation of the Word of God is the re-opening of the possibility of man to be reunited with His Creator, and the Crucifixion is the way that possibility becomes a reality. It is the dividing line between Christianity and all of the religions of the world, even the three great monotheistic Abrahamic religions. The document *Dominus Jesus* was released in the last Jubilee Year, 2000, from the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, precisely to remind everyone in the Church that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life, and is the only way to the Father.

But we also remember that religion is a natural virtue of the realization of man that He is not alone in this world. The natural virtue of religion is incomplete and imperfect, but it is a thing, and manifests itself in all of the religions of the world. While those religions are not themselves positively willed by God or ways to God, they do contain, to a greater or lesser extent, seeds of truth that the Church Fathers called *praeambula fidei* – preambles to faith.

Fifty years ago next month, the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council put out a groundbreaking document on the relationship of the Catholic Church to other religions, making very specific mention of the other two Abrahamic religions: Judaism and Islam. Many traditional Catholics have been very skeptical about this document, and some of the other documents that have come about from the Holy See in the intervening period. It is certainly true that they have been manipulated to encourage religious indifferentism and forms of prayer that are violations of the prohibition of communion in sacred things without the unity of faith. But it is also clear that cooperation with people of good will, even not of our faith, for the good of humanity, is a good thing.

I encourage you to go to the Vatican website to read and pray over this document. As an aid to understanding how authentic inter-religious dialogue can promote peace and justice, we have decided to have an annual event called the *Nostra aetate* Forum named after the document to explore fraternity with members of our own local community who are not Christian. On the traditional Feast of Christ the King this year, 26 October, we will have the first iteration of this event with friends from the local Islamic community, since Islam is the largest religion after Christianity, and the fastest growing. The events are meant to inform, connect and inspire, and will always be done within the confines of what the Holy See expects for any form of inter-religious dialogue.


