#### Letter from our Pastor

#### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

The most important physical object of any church is the altar. It is the place where the sacrifice of Calvary is renewed in an unbloody manner. Even the tabernacle where Our Lord dwells cannot be if there is no altar. And there are churches that have altars but no tabernacles. The church has always had specific disciplines and traditions surrounding the construction and use of altars. Except for Good Friday, the altar is always vested with three fair linen cloths, which symbolize the swaddling clothes in the manger, the veil of the Passion and the shroud which enveloped the Savior in the tomb. They have practical use for the service of the sacred liturgy.

The altar itself is also covered with what is called an *antependium*, which is just from the Latin for "hangs in front of." Because our altar is massive and free standing, it takes a lot of cloth to make an antependium. The current antependia we have were made by parishioners and by a specialist company in London called Watts. Several of them are in bad shape, as you can imagine any cloth would be after 20 years of use.

Sometimes a parishioners wants to give a dedicated gift for the worship of God. A "Latin Mass family which wants to remain anonymous" wanted to give something in honor of a dear mother. And so after a lovely discussion, we settled on a white antependium from Watts. To do this, I worked with them to come up with proposals for other frontals for the future as well. These are neither budgeted or priority ítems, of course, but are given out of a great love for the altar of sacrifice.

The "Latin Mass Family" donors want to issue a challenge to the other families who frequent the I2N Mass on Sundays to help provide the other frontals as well. And so, we issue that challenge today if you're interested. It's a great way to memorialise a significant visual item in the church. And of course, even if you are not a Noon Mass devotee, you can participate if you want.


