Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Clergy and laity who are involved in full time ministry often have theological degrees with a significant background in the humanities. Yet their work often involves much more than just theology; psychology, business, languages, the arts, finance, and so much more all bring their insights into the work of the Church. Continuing education is extremely important for our staff so that they may always have new refreshing sources of inspiration and knowledge. Participation in seminars, conferences and professional organizations may take time away from the parish, but are necessary building blocks for what we do. A culture of excellence and constant improvement helps make a vibrant staff form a creative community.

Father Tomlinson is a member of the Catholic Biblical Association of America, a professional organization for scholars and theologians with research in Scripture.

Maestro Philip Reed has participated for several years in Duke University's summer programs in sacred music and choral conducting, and Organist Elizabeth Wilson often participates in the stellar Colloquium provided by the Church Music Association of America.

Pastoral Associate Michael Sandifer was invited to participate in the McGrath Institute for Church Life at the University of Notre Dame. This prestigious program offers a number of courses and concentrations for church ministry workers and an extensive network of professional development opportunities.

Pastoral Associate Maria Barontini also was a part of the Contours of Wonder initiative of the McGrath Institute at Notre Dame on children and liturgy.

Communications Director Kylee Jean Heap has been doing extensive studies on grief accompaniment and pro-life support.

Principal Nathan Barontini completes next month the rigorous Certificate in School Management and Leadership (CSML) offered in conjunction with the famous Harvard Business School and Harvard Graduate School of Education. This year long program partners a cohort of school administrators from all the world with the brightest minds in business and education to analyze complex cases and come up with projects for school innovation and problem solving.

Father Christopher Smith is also completing the CSML program along with the Principal. After completing the Advanced Management course at the Yale School of Management this spring, he was accepted to the Youth Ministry Institute of Yale Divinity School, an intense year long distance program culminating in a final event in New Haven, which goes into deep work on issues in the formation of adolescents and adults. Fr Smith is a member of the Society for Catholic Liturgy. He will participate in their 30th anniversary conference in Washington, and has been tapped to speak at the National Catholic Education Association Conference in Minneapolis in 2026.

Our staff work very hard, often over and above what any "normal" job requires. And over and above that, they commit their own time, talent and treasure into continuing education opportunities to grow their professional skill set for service to Prince of Peace and the wider community. All of the above people are also integral parts of diocesan conversations and boards, and a number of other professional organizations that tap into their experience in the parish and so much more.
