
Dear Parishioners,

Saturday is the Solemnity of All Saints. We will have Latin Mass at 8a and English Mass at 10a on Saturday. But we will also have on Friday afternoon at 4p a proper Vigil Mass with the Procession of our own little saints at the beginning of the Mass. We do not ordinarily do an anticipated Mass for Holy Days, but with the day falling on a weekend, we thought it useful to do so this year.

Sunday is 2 November. In the Ordinary Form, the Commemoration of All Souls is observed on Sunday, but in the Extraordinary Form it is transferred to Monday. But Monday the priests of the Diocese are called to Myrtle Beach for retreat. So there will be an EF Requiem at 7p on Monday with Fr Davison.

The way the calendar falls and the rubrics for the two forms present a unique set of circumstances this year. Remember to bring pictures of your loved ones who have gone before us to put on the Wall of Remembrance, and to take them home the last Sunday of November. Don't forget your envelope for All Souls, which will remain on the High Altar for the duration of next month. And, if you have experienced a miscarriage, please send me a private message so we can place a white flower for every child miscarried on the Altar of Saint Joseph for All Souls. #### 40 days for life



#### all souls day

This year, All Souls Day (the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed) falls on Sunday, 2 November in the Ordinary Form. Masses to pray for the souls of the just being purified for the vision of God will follow our regular Sunday schedule. In the Extraordinary Form, All Souls Day is transferred to Monday, 3 November, with Latin Mass at 7p.

To honor the feast, the St. Cecilia Choir will present Johann Caspar Kerll's Missa pro defunctis ("Mass for the Dead") at the 10a English Mass on Sunday, 2 November, and again at the 7p Latin Mass on Monday. Scored for choir, soloists, three violas, and organ, this contemplative Baroque Requiem—admired by Pachelbel, Handel, and Bach—offers a moving musical tribute to the faithful departed.

Each registered household received **two** All Souls envelopes in the September/October packet. Please write the names of your beloved deceased on one and place it in the offertory during October; these names will rest on the Altar through November. The second envelope is for your Sunday offering. To have the name of a loved one who has died since All Souls Day 2024 read before Mass, contact the parish office. (Those with funerals here are already included.)

The St. Joseph Altar will feature candles for parishioners who died since last year. Candles may be picked up beginning I December. A vase of white roses will remember all miscarried babies, with a single red rose in memory of those lost to abortion.

Our All Souls Novena will be in the "How to Help Send Souls to Heaven" packet available in the 18–19 October bulletin. The Novena begins 25 October.

#### all saints day

All Saints Day is Saturday, I November. This is when the Church commemorates all saints. A great prayer to be said on this date is the Litany of the Saints. Masses will be:

- 4p Friday, 31 October: Vigil Mass with Family Procession of the Saints
- 8a Saturday, I November: Latin Mass
- IOa Saturday, I November: English Mass

Correction: The obligation to attend Mass has been abrogated this year due to it falling on a Saturday.
