Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

A friend of mine sent me a link to the Catholic Leadership Institute website, and there was a discussion about an inventory for parishioners about data driven information to guide parish decision making. I think initiatives like this are very useful, especially in parishes that are trying to figure out how to become vibrant, or where people need to find a voice. Our people don't seem to have a problem at all expressing what they like and don't like, want and don't want, to the parish clergy and lay leadership. I hope that is a sign of openness and trust. And sometimes there are things the faithful want and like that we have to say no to, merely because of limitations of time and space in a growing parish. That is why it is so important for you all to participate in the Peace in Progress Capital Campaign for our present and our future.

The Institute website had some fascinating statistics I want to share with you:

39% of parishioners want to grow in their faith

31% of registered Catholics in the US attend Mass weekly

80% of all donations are made by just 6.8% of parishioners

8.3 million people (!) are estimated to leave the Church in the next 10-20 years.

I have to say, it's really sad to me that 61% of people who are registered parishioners don't want to grow in their faith. No wonder we got problems. A disciple of Christ is a life-long learner, and the attitude of "I got all I need by eighth grade CCD" means we have a lot of Catholics who have a middle schooler's formation in the faith. And then we wonder why their faith can't withstand the very real problems of the modern world, and why 8.3M are set to apostasise. We have to challenge and change the mindset so 100% of our parishioners want to grow in their faith. And if 69% of registered parishioners aren't even going to Mass every weekend, think of the spiritual impact of that. Now, sometimes people are sick or homebound or just away a few weeks out of the year; but what about the spiritual impact of those who are in mortal sin just by deliberately violating the 2nd commandment? How can a parish be healthy if people aren't receiving the nourishment of the Bread of Life? Last fiscal year we had 1245 active families registered in the parish but only an average of 1766 people at Mass on any given weekend. And that does not count the almost 2000 families that are registered of which some 800 are inactive. We come to Mass and see a lot of people, and if all 2000 families were coming to Mass 75% of the time, we would need to add several Mass times!

And the finances. In our country, 6.8% of parishioners are floating 80% of the donations to the Church. In other parts of the country, churches are closing. And when this happens, people get mad and say, "My grandfather was a founding member of this church and built it with his own hands." Yet they haven't darkened the door since their Confirmation and haven't given a dime to their parish, and yet are shocked that a church can't stay open on hot air alone. Hot air of people who say they care but don't, and of clergy who talk a lot about increasing people in the Church, but do very little.

Are you the 93.2% of parishioners who expect so much of the Church, but do not give according to your means? Are you expecting someone else to do what we are called to do together? Let's change that. 100% participation at Mass (outside of legitimate excuses or the occasional vacation) and 100% participation in the 10% biblical tithe: 5% to the weekly offertory, 1% to the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina, and 4% to the Peace in Progress Capital Campaign for the future!

An interesting historical outlier, this chant mass was composed by Du Mont (1610-1684), a French baroque composer, centuries after Gregorian chant's medieval heyday. Du Mont actually wrote six such "royal masses," but the first, which we will sing, has persisted as a musical staple over the centuries and is often included alongside the traditional medieval options in chant books, particularly in France. The music will be printed in the music sheet, so practice your chant reading skills and sing along with us!



1st Quarter FY26 Financial Statements Note

The Year-to-Date (Y-T-D) Offertory of \$477.2K is favorable to Budget by \$44.0K, and ahead of the previous year by \$48.2K. A significant amount to the variance is due to the timing of multiple large donations and should balance out during the rest of the fiscal year. Our Total Parish Expenses continue to be managed and show that we are slightly favorable to Budget by \$5.9K at the bottom line expense. The net result is showing a \$50.1K Y-T-D surplus and a Y-T-D favorable variance to Budget of \$35.6K for the 1st Quarter of our fiscal year. The balance sheet reflects an improvement in cash since the end of the year by about \$46K which closely follows our bottom line surplus variance to Budget. Our working capital requirements may require us to withdraw \$50K from our savings during this fiscal year depending on how well we sustain Offertory performance. This year, our Cross Project is our main item to complete. We are hoping to complete that project by December 1st. At this time, we believe we are on track to achieve the full year Budget. 
