Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Failure to plan on your part does not constitute an emergency on my part.

Prince of Peace is a very busy place, and because of that, we have to be very strategic in getting people information about what is going on here and scheduling activities and events. The parish staff often plans out more than a year in advance, and it is necessary for ministries and organisations to be pro-active in planning far in advance. It is also needed for everyone to realise that the publication of bulletin, calendar and social media posts takes time, and doing something at the last minute is a good way to not get something on the calendar or not publicized at all.

We have increased demands on our facilities to provide space and PR for more and more events and activities of ministries. But part of the growing pains is also communicating our expectation that those taking the initiative need to be very clear about our realistic time frames and limitations in scheduling and communications. Last minute frantic phone calls and emails when the office is closed or to staff members on their personal time off are signs that things are not thought through well. And if they're not, it is not the job of the staff to make up for lack of prior planning.

Even as the fruit of the capital campaign will be that we will be able to say yes to things that we will have more space for, especially during the day, we need to reiterate that this availability means more puzzle pieces that we have to put together, and that we need cooperation and realistic expectations and understanding to be on everyone's radar screen.

I don't want to have to tell people no to good and worthy things. But no the answer will be if the request does not respect the process for planning and publicizing events! Help us help you to receive a yes, by planning early and often, and communicating well in advance, and frequently. Then my frown may be turned upside down!

beginning year a

Did you know the Church's Lectionary follows two different cycles—one for Sundays and one for weekdays? The Sunday cycle runs on a three-year pattern: Year A highlights the Gospel of Matthew, Year B focuses on Mark (with chapter 6 of John), and Year C centers on Luke. Portions of the Gospel of John are proclaimed every year, especially during the Easter season.

The liturgical year doesn't begin on January I, but on the First Sunday of Advent, when we shift into the next cycle.

At Mass, the first reading—usually from the Old Testament—echoes the theme of the Gospel, while the second reading, typically from an epistle, moves almost continuously week to week.

Year A readings in the St. Isaac Jogues Missal begin on 30 November.




