Letter from our Pastor



An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Pope Leo XIV in his apostolic exhortation *Dilexit te* on the Church and the poor talks about why Catholic education is one of the most important ways of helping raise people out of poverty. The school is the primary apostolate of the parish for handing on the Catholic faith. And as we go into capital fundraising mode to provide facilities for better addressing our educational and ministerial needs, it is important to remember that education is part of the Church's mission for integral human development. The Pope discusses it smartly, and may it inspire you as you discern your pledge for the *Peace in Progress* campaign:

For the Christian faith, the education of the poor is not a favor but a duty. Children have a right to knowledge as a fundamental requirement for the recognition of human dignity. Teaching them affirms their value, giving them the tools to transform their reality. Christian tradition considers knowledge a gift from God and a community responsibility. Christian education does not only form professionals, but also people open to goodness, beauty and truth. Catholic schools, therefore, when they are faithful to their name, are places of inclusion, integral formation and human development. By combining faith and culture, they sow the seeds of the future, honor the image of God and build a better society.

No child who comes to Prince of Peace Catholic School pays the full freight of what it costs to educate a child here. The parish subsidizes part of the operating budget, and we actually fundraise through the POPArt Party, not for nice extras, but for operating expenses related to improving the educational experience. Besides that, the ESTF program with the State of South Carolina provides funding for many of our families who would not otherwise be able to come, and financial assistance to those with demonstrated need kicks in for those who ESTF does not cover. To keep the school fiscally responsible, tuition and fundraising try to provide the best education for those who are a good fit for the school.

The school has immediate needs for security upgrades in the context of our increasingly violent world. Right now, the children in the school and RE are constantly going back and forth between various buildings, and the *Peace in Progress* campaign can put the kids under one roof with renewed and new facilities that can be re-envisioned and reconfigured with greater safety features than we presently have. As more and more parishioners want more and more ministries, we need to provide more space that is adequate for those needs outside the school as well. It is time to build a permanent middle school building integrated into the already existing Lourdes and Walsingham Halls. Guadalupe Hall, the modular building, can be repurposed for parish use even during the day, which has become crucial as our space needs expand.

Please consider now as large of a sacrificial gift at the beginning of this campaign as you can possibly give, and also what a monthly pledge for the next 3 years might look like. Generations past of Prince of Peace parishioners sacrificed so we can have what we have now. Let us honor them now by meeting the needs of the present and future.

christ the king

Join us for a special Choral Mass for Christ the King on Sunday, 23 November at the 10a Mass. The St Cecilia Choir will sing the Mass Ordinary to Henri Du Mont's Missa Regia, or "Royal Mass." An interesting historical outlier, this chant mass was composed by Du Mont (1610-1684), a French baroque composer, centuries after Gregorian chant's medieval heyday. Du Mont actually wrote six such "royal masses," but the first, which we will sing, has persisted as a musical staple over the centuries and is often included alongside the traditional medieval options in chant books, particularly in France. The music will be printed in the music sheet, so practice your chant reading skills and sing along with us!




