Dear Parishioners,

God gives us all the opportunity and means to participate in the building of His Church.

We joined Prince of Peace in 2022 and have inherited the work and generosity of all the parishioners before us. The church building, the school, and the parish life; all of these are here because of those who listened and followed God's calling and for them, we are truly grateful. Even in only three years, my family has visibly seen the growth of the size of the community, the enrollment in the school, and the ministries.

We have a second grader and kindergartener enrolled in the school, but I would like to take this opportunity to speak about a different ministry I am involved with at the church: the men's Bible study. I personally have been involved with the men's Bible study since we joined. I have also been able to see this ministry flourish with many new faces. The study meets in Guadalupe Hall and when I first started, we all sat in middle school student desks. I think I can speak for the entire group when I say that lab tables have been a much welcomed upgrade. At times, the attendance has been so large that we have filled those seats and brought other folding chairs in to accommodate the group.

At this time, one benefit (blessing) of meeting in the middle school is that we know and pray for the middle schoolers' intentions along with our personal intentions at the beginning of each session. Lord-willing, we can continue this tradition as our campus grows, but for now, it has been a silver-lining to meeting in the middle school space.

My family is taking advantage of this program. Quite often these exclude contributions to churches, but often allow for religious affiliated schools. All these talents and treasures are meant for the building of His kingdom. 
high solemn rorate mass

Between 14-21 December, we will have Seminarian Leo Gibson at our parish. Please extend a warm "hello" to him when you see him! In his own words:




I grew up in Spartanburg




