#### fr smith named dean

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Bishop is assisted in the administration of the Diocese by what are called Vicars Forane, which in this country are usually known as Deans. The Diocese is divided up into regional deaneries, and Deans are appointed for three year terms to be the representative of the Bishop for certain administrative tasks. The Deans also sit on a number of consultative bodies, such as Presbyteral Council, Personnel Board and the College of Consultors. Deans often do parish visits, installations of new pastors, confirmations in the absence of the Bishop, and fulfill other tasks of coordinating pastoral ministry at the instruction of the Bishop. Father Jay Scott Newman has admirably fulfilled this role in our Greenville Deanery for over fourteen years now. The Deanery stretches from Walhalla in the West to Gaffney in the East and from the North Carolina border to Newberry.

Bishop Fabre-Jeune has appointed me as the Dean of the Greenville Deanery effective I December for a three year term. I am grateful to Father Newman for his work in the past and will work closely with him during this transition. I remain at Prince of Peace as Pastor. But it does mean that there are a number of tasks that I will be required to do, and many more meetings. Father Tomlinson as the Parochial Vicar will naturally then also have more to do in the administrative and pastoral life of the parish. I ask that you be patient with me. The Good Lord hasn't given any of us any more time to do the work He has given us to do, and I have to figure out how to keep a balanced life as I navigate these new duties. I would like to prepare you now for the fact that we all need to be flexible when it. comes to my availability for meetings and events in the parish. Please be aware that it might take longer for some meetings to be scheduled, and I will need to rely heavily on my staff in handling some things that until now I handled directly or more quickly.

Please pray for me as I undertake this new role for the good of the Church that I may be a good pastor of souls for you as well as helpful to the Bishop of Charleston as a cooperator in his apostolic ministry in the vineyard.

### adoration chapel vandalism

Dear Friends in Christ,

It has come to my attention that people are coming to the Adoration Chapel and leaving books, magazines, and religious articles that are not authorized. All such articles are disposed of as soon as they are identified. Please remember that the church and the chapel are not your private property and not a dumping ground for things you do not want or literature that you want to disseminate. Furthermore, as if that were not enough, the signs put in the chapel instructing people to cease and desist doing this, and informing people that unauthorized items will be discarded, have been removed and trashed.

We will be installing new security cameras in the chapel to identify the perpetrators of such acts of vandalism and will then work with law enforcement to address these acts. I ask the various section leaders to contact Phil Head, the Director of Administration, immediately upon noticing such acts, and we will review the security footage and take appropriate action, which will begin with loss of access to the chapel. The Chapel is the property of Christ the Eucharistic King and the parish administration has a duty to protect its sacred character and its orderliness as a part of the parish. If you are doing these kinds of things, stop it immediately.


