From Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

This week we commemorate the sad anniversary of 1973 US Supreme Court decision *Roe v. Wade*, which ruled that there was a constitutional right to abortion in this country. It was not the first time that the Supreme Court had upheld a supposed constitutional right to a travesty against human dignity. For most of the intervening 53 years, much of the activity of pro-life advocates and the Church was to overturn that Supreme Court decision. Many of our parishioners were involved in numerous initiatives to see that day come, and also to provide alternatives to abortion as well as encourage a culture of life. In 2022, *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organisation* overturned the previous decision, and for the most part returned regulation to the states. In South Carolina, abortion is now illegal after the detection of a fetal heartbeat, which is around 5-6 weeks after conception, and that law stands after a legal challenge according to the state Supreme Court. The nature of pro-life legal advocacy and the landscape of abortion-related activities has massively changed since 2022. We have seen how language has been misused and abused to further the genocide of millions of Americans, and how lying to mothers about the physical and emotional effects of abortion has lined the pockets of unscrupulous people and created millions of victims who have been gaslighted into thinking that they had been empowered. Abortifacient drugs are a new frontier in the battle against the culture of death, and we are nowhere near seeing the end of the issues that these are causing.


The Catholic Church still stands as one of the few religious groups who has not succumbed to the culture of death, and is the most powerful voice for life in our time. A consistent ethic of life has always marked Catholic teaching, which boiled down to its essence is quite simple: Life is beautiful. It's not about making abortion just illegal, it's about making it unthinkable, so that any woman who finds herself with child knows that there are so many options out there that she will always be supported.

Saint Clare's Home here in Greenville, the inspiration of our very own Clare Pizzuti, is an answer. So it is vital that we participate in that great work of hope. Also, we ask that you become familiar with another important initiative. Bookmark www.supportafterabortion.com and check out its incredible resources. There is always hope and healing, and their staff does a monumental job in changing hearts and minds of men and women whose lives have been touched by abortion.

Celebrated forty days after Christmas, it commemorates the Presentation of the Lord and Our Lady's obedience to the Mosaic Law, as prescribed in *Leviticus 12:2-8*. A **blessing of candles** will take place during **Latin Mass on Monday, 2 February at 7p**.

Candles for the blessing should be placed on the table **inside the communion rail before Mass**. You may bring your own candles or purchase them through the parish office.
