From Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

Archbishop Fulton Sheen once famously commented, "There is not one person in the United States who hates the Catholic Church, but there are millions who hate what they think the Catholic Church is." I found that, growing up in South Carolina, there was so much ignorance and outright lying about what Catholicism was really about, that many people hated and feared Catholics. As I learned that what I had been taught did not reflect at all what the Church taught, I began to want to discover what the Church actually taught. And that led me to the realization that the exclusive truth claims of the Catholic Church to be the fullness of truth demanded a response. In March 1991 I was received into full communion with that Church.

But the experience of converting to a religion that was misunderstood and maligned made me very skeptical about people who felt the need to pontificate about other people's religions, because I saw how far their lies were removed from the reality of the beauty of my faith, and how it made peaceful co-existence, or just simple tolerance, impossible. It also made me want to learn more about world religions and Christian communities not because of some vague belief that all religions are equal, but because of one simple truth I learned:

Ignorance is dangerous. Lies are dangerous.


As Catholics I know how much you get frustrated when others talk poorly about your faith, your priests, your parishes, your beliefs. And you know how hurtful discrimination and prejudice against Catholics can be. So I have a question: why would we not extend that same grace to others who have a different religion? Extending the grace of becoming educated about other religions and challenging falsehoods is not lapsing into the heresy of religious indifferentism. It means you're a decent human being. Truth does not need defenders; it needs witnesses. And likewise, lies and misinformation need the clarification of calm investigation and real human contact.

Think about that the next time you consume poisonous social media and parrot what others say about non-Catholics, whether they be Anglicans or Pentecostals, or Muslims or Jews. If you are spending more time reading nonsense on the internet about people who ascribe to these religions rather than reading what their practitioners have to say about their beliefs and actually talking to them like decent human beings, you're in serious danger of allowing yourself to be deceived by pride, arrogance and haughtiness.

Knowledge is power. Truth is power.

candlemas

Candlemas, also known as the **Feast of Light**, is a day of purification, renewal, and hope. Celebrated forty days after Christmas, it commemorates the Presentation of the Lord and Our Lady's obedience to the Mosaic Law, as prescribed in *Leviticus 12:2-8*. A **blessing of candles** will take place during **Latin Mass on Monday, 2 February at 7p**.

Candles for the blessing should be placed on the table **inside the communion rail before Mass**. You may bring your own candles or purchase them through the parish office.

Parish candle purchase details:

- **Price:** Two 8" candles per box – \$5
- **How to order:** Place payment in the collection basket and write "Candlemas candles" with your name on the envelope
- **Distribution:** On 2 February, purchased candles will be placed on the table inside the communion rail with your name on the box
