From Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Parishioners,

I am both proud and saddened to announce that our Director of Music and Choirmaster, Maestro Philip Reed, will be leaving Prince of Peace at the end of June to pursue a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at Yale University. Jeanie Reed, who has served as our school music teacher and parish children’s music specialist for the past three years, will also be retiring at the end of this school year following a long and illustrious career.

Maestro Reed is finishing his fifth year as Director of Music, but his role in music at Prince of Peace stretches back to 2009, when he began singing in the St. Cecilia choir under his father, Alan Reed, who served as our music director from 2004-2021. Philip continued to sing and conduct at Prince of Peace throughout his undergraduate studies at Furman University, as well as during his Master’s degree in choral conducting at the University of Georgia. In 2018, he moved abroad, first to Taipei and then to Tokyo, where he completed a second Master’s degree using his knowledge of Gregorian chant to conduct comparative research on Japanese Buddhist chant notation. Upon his father’s retirement in 2021, he returned to Greenville to become Interim Director of Music, followed by his permanent appointment to the post in 2022. During his tenure, our music program has continued to flourish, with highlights including the Missa Luba sung by three choirs for Pentecost 2024, the premiere of Maestro Reed’s own Missa Verbum caro for Midnight Mass 2024, the musical extravaganza that was the First Mass of Fr. Daniel Perry on Pentecost Sunday 2025, and the arrival of our new Klop continuo organ in December 2025.

Jeanie Reed, Philip’s mother, came to Prince of Peace three years ago following an illustrious 39-year career as a music teacher in the Greenville County School District. For 24 of those years she taught at Stone Academy, the district’s arts magnet elementary school, where she built a renowned music program and touched the lives of countless students, many of whom have gone on to become successful professional musicians. Following her retirement from Greenville County in 2023, she was appointed School Music Teacher and Pastoral Associate for Children’s Music at Prince of Peace and has spent the past three years working wonders with the students of our school and parish.

The Reeds have asked me to express their heartfelt gratitude to the Prince of Peace parish family for all of the kindness and support they have received in the more than two decades in which their family has served our parish. Philip also assures me that we will continue to welcome him back for performances by his professional choral ensemble, Chicora Voices, which will continue during his studies at Yale.

Maestro Reed’s last Sunday with us will be Corpus Christi, 7 June. In the meantime, we will be conducting a national search to fill both of these critical positions and the very large shoes the Reeds leave behind. Interested applicants can find descriptions of the positions [on our website](#) homepage and submit their materials for the Director of Music and Choirmaster (full time) and School Music Teacher and Pastoral Associate for Children’s Music (part time), both with benefits.

We are grateful for the years of faithful service the Reeds have offered and ask for your prayers as we seek the right people to carry our music ministry forward.

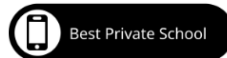
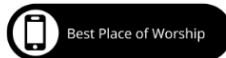
